22	AGENDA ITEM 5, 5A, IS AGREEMENTS TO ADVANCE THE STATE ROUTE 37
23	SEARS POINT TO MARE ISLAND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. REQUEST FOR
24	APPROVALS OF AGREEMENTS TO ADVANCE THE STATE ROUTE 37 SEARS

POINT TO MARE ISLAND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT INTO DESIGN PHASE: I.



- 1 COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT INTEGRATED TEAM FOR DESIGN FOR STATE
- 2 ROUTE 37 SEARS POINT TO MARE ISLAND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT:
- 3 CALTRANS (\$20,000,000) II. FUNDING AGREEMENT DESIGN PHASE
- 4 FUNDING FOR THE STATE ROUTE 37 SEARS POINT TO MARE ISLAND
- 5 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT: SONOMA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY
- 6 (\$4,000,000). THIS IS AN INFORMATION ITEM, AND KEVIN CHEN WILL
- 7 BE PRESENTING. KEVIN, WHENEVER YOU'RE READY.

- 9 KEVIN CHEN: THANK YOU. GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. KEVIN CHEN,
- 10 MTC STAFF. WE HAVE SLIDES. I'M HERE TO PRESENT ON 5A
- 11 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT I'LL START WITH INFORMATION ON THE
- 12 PROJECT. THIS IS A JOINT EFFORT BETWEEN MTC, CALTRANS, AND THE
- 13 FOUR NORTH BAY COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITIES INCLUDING
- 14 MARIN, SONOMA, SOLANO, AND NAPA. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. A BIT OF
- 15 BACKGROUND. HIGHWAY 37 IS THE NORTHERNMOST NON-MOUNTAINOUS
- 16 EAST WEST CONNECTOR IN THE REGION 20 MILES CONNECTING US101 IN
- 17 MARIN TO 180 IN SOLANO MIDDLE STREP OF THE CORRIDOR IN BLUE
- 18 BETWEEN SEARS POINT AND MARE ISLAND TWO MILES IS A TWO-WAY
- 19 CONVENTIONAL HIGHWAY WITH JUST ONE LANE IN EACH DIRECTION THIS
- 20 CREATES BOTTLENECK AND DELAYS ON A DAILY BASIS. IT CREATES AN
- 21 EQUITY CHALLENGE BECAUSE HIGHWAY 37 IS A KEY CORRIDOR THAT
- 22 CONNECTS AFFORDABLE HOMES ON THE EAST BAY SIDE TO JOBS IN
- 23 MARIN AND SONOMA COUNTIES. ALSO THERE IS CURRENTLY NO PUBLIC
- 24 TRANSIT ON THIS CORRIDOR WHICH REALLY LIMITS TRAVEL OPTIONS
- 25 FOR COMMUTERS. THERE IS NO PRACTICAL OR CONVENIENT ALTERNATE



- 1 ROUTES TO HIGHWAY 37 TO GET FOLKS ACROSS FROM EAST TO WEST.
- 2 HAVING AN EQUITABLE TRANSPORTATION SOLUTION HERE ON THIS
- 3 CORRIDOR IS CRITICAL. I WOULD LIKE TO MENTION HIGHWAY 37 IS
- 4 DESIGNATED AS A RECOVERY ROUTE WHICH MEANS THE HIGHWAY IS
- 5 GOING TO BE CRUCIAL TO FUNCTION AS A RELIABLE EVACUATION AND
- 6 EMERGENCY ACCESS ROUTE. THE PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT IS TO
- 7 ADDRESS THE TRAFFIC CONGESTION ON HOW HIGHWAY 37 TO IMPROVE
- 8 TRAFFIC FLOW DURING PEAK TRAVEL TIMES AND INCREASE VEHICLE
- 9 OCCUPANCY BY PROMOTING USE OF CARPOOLING AND BUS TRANSIT. KEY
- 10 PROJECT COMPONENTS. WE ARE PROVIDING HOV LANES WHICH WOULD
- 11 ENABLE CARPOOL LANE WE'LL BE PROVIDING BUS TRANSIT SERVICE AS
- 12 WELL AS PUBLIC ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS. WE WILL ALSO BE INSTALLING
- 13 ITS ELEMENTS THESE ARE TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS SUCH AS VARIABLE
- 14 MESSAGING, SIGNS, CAMERAS AND SO FORTH THAT WOULD BE VERY
- 15 IMPORTANT IN MANAGING INCIDENTS. WE'LL BE PROVIDING ECOLOGICAL
- 16 ENHANCEMENTS THAT I'LL TALK MORE ABOUT IN THE NEXT SLIDE. LAST
- 17 BUT NOT LEAST THIS PROJECT WILL IMPLEMENT TOLLING PENDING
- 18 ADDITIONAL APPROVALS. TOLLING IS IMPORTANT IN TWO ASPECTS, ONE
- 19 IT PROVIDES DIRECT SOURCE OF FUNDING THAT GOES TOWARDS FUNDING
- 20 FOR THE PROJECT. TOLLING IS A TOOL FOR US TO BE ABLE TO MANAGE
- 21 TRAFFIC CONGESTION EFFECTIVELY. TOLLING IN COMBINATION WITH
- 22 THE HOV LANE AND TRANSIT WOULD REALLY HELP ENCOURAGE THE USE
- 23 OF CARPOOLING AND TRANSIT ON THIS CORRIDOR WHICH WOULD IN FACT
- 24 REDUCE VEHICLE TRIPS AND REDUCE VEHICLE MILES OF TRAVEL
- 25 CONSISTENT WITH BOTH REGIONAL AND STATE GOALS. NEXT SLIDE



- 1 PLEASE. SO, WITH THIS PROJECT WE ARE ADDRESSING SEVERAL KEY
- 2 ISSUES ON THIS CORRIDOR. FIRST ONCE AGAIN IS EQUITY, AS
- 3 COMMUTERS ON THIS CORRIDOR EXPERIENCE SIGNIFICANT CONGESTION
- 4 ON A DAILY BASIS, WHICH, YOU KNOW, IT TAKES UP TO 100 MINUTES
- 5 FOR PEOPLE TO GET HOME FROM THE MARIN SIDE OF THE CORRIDOR
- 6 BACK TO THE SOLANO SIDE OF THE CORRIDOR IT'S JUST 20 MILES
- 7 WHICH NORMALLY WOULD TAKE 20 MINUTES THAT'S A SIGNIFICANT
- 8 AMOUNT OF DELAY. WITH THIS PROJECT THAT DELAY WILL BE REDUCED
- 9 AND TRAVEL TIME RELIABILITY WILL BE IMPROVED. ONCE AGAIN WE'RE
- 10 INCREASING TRAVEL MODAL OPTIONS FOR COMMUTERS BY IMPLEMENTING
- 11 A NEW BUS TRANSIT SERVICE ON THIS CORRIDOR ALONG WITH THE
- 12 PROJECT. AND THE HOV LANE THAT WE PROVIDE AS PART OF THE
- 13 PROJECT WILL HELP INCENTIVIZE THE USE OF CARPOOLING TO ADDRESS
- 14 EQUITY CONCERNS WE'LL EVALUATE MEANS BASED DISCOUNT PROGRAM.
- 15 WITH THIS PROJECT WE'RE GOING TO BE DELIVERING SUSTAINABILITY.
- 16 WE HAVE BEEN WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE RESOURCE AGENCIES AND
- 17 IDENTIFIED TWO KEY OPPORTUNITIES ON THIS CORRIDOR TO IMPROVE
- 18 ECOLOGY. THE FIRST IS TO ENHANCE THE STRIP MARSH EAST TO
- 19 IMPROVE THE MARSH HABITAT THAT'S RAPIDLY DEGRADING AS WE SPEAK
- 20 DUE TO DRAINAGE PROBLEMS. THIS IS A NATURE-BASED SOLUTION THAT
- 21 MAINTAINS THE SHORELINE EROSION BUFFERS, AND ATTENUATE WAVE
- 22 ENERGY FOR [INDISCERNIBLE] HIGHWAY WHILE PROVIDING NEAR-TERM
- 23 RESILIENCY THE SECOND COMPONENT REPLACEMENT OF THE BRIDGE,
- 24 ACROSS TOLAY CREEK BRIDGE, WITH A LONGER TOLAY CREEK BRIDGE IT
- 25 WOULD HELP SUPPORTING THE BAY LAND STRATEGY THAT'S PLANNED



- 1 NORTH OF HIGHWAY 37 AND THAT'S GOING TO BE TIME CRITICAL TO
- 2 IMPLEMENT AS WELL. LAST BUT NOT LEAST FROM THE RESILIENCE
- 3 STANDPOINT THERE ARE PARTS OF THE PROJECT THAT WOULD BOLSTER
- 4 THE EXISTING HIGHWAY IN THE NEAR-TERM FOR FLOODING BECAUSE THE
- 5 HIGHWAY -- [INDISCERNIBLE] IN TERMS FUNDING, WITH
- 6 IMPLEMENTATION OF TOLLING FOR THIS PROJECT GENERATES FUNDING,
- 7 AND ALLOWS US TO COMPETE FOR MORE STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS IT
- 8 WOULD BECOME A RELIABLE MATCHING FUND SOURCE AS WE COMPETE FOR
- 9 OTHER FUNDS. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. THIS IS MY LAST SLIDE IN TERMS
- 10 OF THIS PROJECT WE'RE GETTING CLOSE TO COMPLETING THE
- 11 ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW PHASE OF THE PROJECT, WITH PROJECTS WITH
- 12 CALTRANS AND WE HOPING TO WRAP UP THIS MONTH DEPENDING ON
- 13 FINAL APPROVALS OF CALTRANS WE'RE STARTING TO DESIGN PHASE OF
- 14 THIS PROJECT, WITH PERMITTING TAKING PLACE OVER THE NEXT TWO
- 15 YEARS AND CONSTRUCTION WILL FOLLOW FOR ANOTHER TWO YEARS WE'RE
- 16 LOOKING AT APPROXIMATELY 2027 FOR OPENING. WE ARE SEEKING
- 17 APPROVAL ON TWO ITEMS FIRST COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH
- 18 CALTRANS FOR \$20 MILLION TO FORM AN INTEGRATED TEAM FOR THE
- 19 DESIGN PHASE OF THIS PROJECT WHICH WE ARE ANTICIPATING TO
- 20 START IN ACKNOWLEDGE MONTHS. THE SECOND ITEM IS FOR A FUNDING
- 21 AGREEMENT WITH THE SONOMA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY IN
- 22 AN AMOUNT OF \$4 MILLION FOR MTC TO RECEIVE FUNDING THAT WOULD
- 23 GO TOWARDS THE DESIGN PHASE OF THE PROJECT. THAT'S IT FROM ME
- 24 AND I'M HAPPY TO TAKE ANY QUESTIONS.



- CAROL DUTRA-VERNACI, CHAIR: THANK YOU VERY MUCH KEVIN. DO ANY 1 2 OF OUR COMMISSIONERS HAVE QUESTIONS ON THIS ITEM? OR COMMENTS? 3 OKAY. I TONIGHT SEE ANY HANDS THERE. MARTHA DO WE HAVE ANY PUBLIC COMMENT ON THIS ITEM? 4 5 CLERK OF THE BOARD: THERE WASN'T WRITTEN CORRESPOND RECEIVED 6 ON THIS ITEM THERE IS ONE MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC WITH THEIR HAND 7 8 RAISED. HOW MUCH TIME WOULD YOU LIKE TO GIVE? 9 CAROL DUTRA-VERNACI, CHAIR: TWO MINUTES. 10 11 CLERK OF THE BOARD: GEORGE SPIES, YOU HAVE TWO MINUTES. 12
- 14 SPEAKER: I WASN'T PLANNING ON COMMENTING ON THIS ITEM BUT I
- 15 WANT TO MAKE A COUPLE OF POINTS. ONE IS A LAND USE PROBLEM,
- 16 THE REASON PEOPLE ARE COMMUTING ON THIS CORRIDOR AND CREATING
- 17 CONGESTION THAT IS THERE IS THAT LAND VALUES ARE FAR TOO HIGH
- 18 IN MARIN BECAUSE BUILDING IS CONSTRAINED THERE. AND, SO,
- 19 SPRAWL HAPPENS OUT IN SOLANO COUNTY FOR PEOPLE WHO WORK IN
- 20 MARIN. SO, THE SOLUTION TO THIS PROBLEM IS NOT TO WIDEN THE
- 21 FREEWAY OR THE HIGHWAY, IT'S TO BUILD MORE HOUSING IN MARIN SO
- 22 THAT PEOPLE WHO WORK THERE CAN LIVE THERE. THE STATE HAS SET
- 23 GOALS FOR THE REDUCTION OF VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED BY 2030
- 24 WHICH I'M GOING TO GUESS IS ABOUT THE TIME THAT THIS THING
- 25 WOULD OPEN AND IF WE WERE TO BE SERIOUS ABOUT MEETING THOSE



- 1 GOALS MAYBE THIS WIDENING WOULDN'T BE OUITE AS NECESSARY IN
- 2 TERMS OF THE CONGESTION PIECE AT LEAST. SO, I WOULD ENCOURAGE
- 3 THE FOLKS WHO ARE ON THIS COMMITTEE AND HAVE CONNECTIONS IN
- 4 MARIN TO CONSIDER THAT LAND USE IS REALLY THE PROBLEM HERE.
- 5 AND THEN, I HOPE, IF THIS DOES GET BUILT, THAT THE CAMERAS
- 6 INVOLVED ARE GOING TO BE AUTOMATED TO PARTICULATE FOLKS WHO
- 7 ARE VIOLATING THE HOV LANE. BECAUSE WHEN YOU RUN BUS RAPID --
