- 1 TO TERMINATE THE AGREEMENT WHICH RELEASES ESCROW. I FEEL LIKE
  2 WE SHOULD CHEER. DEREK OR KATHLEEN?

  4 DEREK HANSEL: I THINK GENERAL COUNSEL IS GOING TO START.
- 5 6 KATHLEEN KANE: I'LL DO A VERY SHORT VICTORY LAP, THEN HAND IT
- 7 TO OUR CFO. IT'S A RARE PIECE OF GOOD NEWS THAT I GET TO
- 8 PRESENT. WE'RE ABLE NOW TO RELEASE THE ESCROW. WE HAVE BEEN
- 9 COLLECTING RM3 WHICH I DO KNOW WAS CHALLENGED ALMOST
- 10 IMMEDIATELY AND HAS BEEN TIED UP IN LITIGATION. AS OF LAST
- 11 MONTH WE'RE ARE NOW FINALLY DONE, AND WE ARE ABLE TO RELEASE
- 12 THE ESCROW AND MOVE FORWARD WITH THE IMPORTANT WORK GETTING
- 13 MONEY OUT THE DOOR. SO, UNLESS YOU HAVE AND LEGAL QUESTIONS, I
- 14 WILL HAND IT OVER TO OUR CFO.
- 16 DEREK HANSEL: AND JUST FOLLOWING UP ON THAT, CERTAINLY WE'RE -
- 17 WE'LL BE [INDISCERNIBLE] THAT ESCROW FAST. [LAUGHTER]. SO,
- 18 REALLY DELIGHTED TO DO THAT. IT'S REALLY A GREAT CREDIT
- 19 POSITIVE FOR BATA IN ADDITION TO PROVIDING ALL OF THIS CAPITAL
- 20 WHICH WILL LET US TO DO ALL THE IMPORTANT WORK AROUND THE
- 21 REGION, AND WE'LL CERTAINLY BE BACK WITH YOU WITH WHAT WE'RE
- 22 DOING TO IMPLEMENT ALL OF THAT. WE'RE SITTING ON SEVERAL
- 23 HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS ALREADY, WHICH IS IN THE ESCROW. THAT
- 24 AMOUNT GROWS BY ABOUT 17 AND A HALF MILLION DOLLARS A MONTH.
- 25 THAT'S THE GOOD NEWS. THE IMPORTANT NEWS IS WE'RE GOING TO



NEED TO BORROW SOME TO MEET ALL THESE THINGS AS WELL. SO WE'RE 1 WORKING UP THOSE PLANS AS WELL AND WE'LL BE BACK TO YOU AS WE 2 NEED TO. LOOKING FORWARD TO IT. 3 4 5 CHAIR, ALFREDO PEDROZA: THANK YOU COUNSEL AND DEREK. AND TO COUNSEL, THANK YOU FOR YOUR EFFORT IN THE VERY BEGINNING. YOU 6 HAVE PROVIDED US GOOD COUNSEL AND YOU HAVE ALSO PROVIDED US A 7 8 GOOD TEAM. WE CAN BE EXCITED ABOUT THIS BUT THE PUBLIC WINS TODAY. WE HAVE A LOT OF LETTERS OF NO PREJUDICE 13 OUT THERE. SOONER RATHER THAN LATER WE WOULD LIKE YOU TO COME 14 15 BACK AND PRESENT THAT TO US. 16 ANDREW FREMIER: WE CAN DO THAT. WE PLAN ON RELEASING MONEY 17 SOON. WE HAVE BEEN TALKING TO A LOT OF PROJECTS SPONSORS 18 ALREADY ABOUT GETTING THE PROCESS, GETTING PROJECTS UPDATED. 19 SO, WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO GETTING THOSE DOLLARS PUT TO WORK 20 21 QUICKLY. 22 23 CHAIR, ALFREDO PEDROZA: THANK YOU, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

IT FEELS GOOD TO GET THOSE AND THEN I CAN DECIDE 17 WHAT TO DO WITH THEM. I HAVE BEEN GETTING DIRECT DEPOSITS FOR 18 OVER 30 YEARS IT'S HOW I RECEIVE MY MONEY. WE HAVE OUR CHANCE. 19 YES, THE PUBLIC DOES WIN TODAY WITH THIS DIRECT DEPOSIT. IT 20 WAS A DREAM DEFERRED, FORTUNATELY, IT IS NOT A DREAM DENIED. I 21 LOOK FORWARD TO YOUR REPORTING ON WHAT WE'RE GOING TO DO WITH 22 THIS TO HELP BUILD THE BEST BATA THAT WE CAN. LET'S GET TO 23 WORK. THANK YOU. 24

- 13 LOOK FORWARD TO US BUILDING THE BEST BATA THAT WE CAN. THANK
