- The Regional Transit Connection (RTC) Clipper access card is a discount program for people with qualifying disabilities. It has existed since the 1990s and now is formally one of Clipper's discount programs. The RTC Clipper Access card provides an easy way to pay for fares and access the discount across all the Clipper agencies.
- The Clipper® BayPass is a two-year pilot that provides fare-free travel on all Clipper agencies, including Caltrain. The pilot program leverages the Clipper fare payment system to provide access to fare-free transit well as collect data about travel. This pilot is an opportunity to learn more about how pilot participants use transit across all agencies in the region when part of a fare-free program. The pilot will collect both quantitative and qualitative data about participants' travel. Based on pilot findings, there may be recommendations to revise the program to include other transit agencies.
