FY 2021-22 Federal Earmark Repurposing

Subject:

Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) repurposed earmark funds under the earmark repurposing provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022.

Background:

The federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 includes a provision enabling states to repurpose unused earmark balances from projects that have not substantially progressed, or that are completed and closed.

FY 2021-22 Earmark Repurposing – MTC Submittal

In July, the Commission directed staff to develop and submit to Caltrans the list of Bay Area earmarks for repurposing. This agenda item is a follow-up to the Commission to report earmarks that MTC submitted to Caltrans for repurposing this year.

Staff worked with affected project sponsors, transit agencies, and County Transportation Agencies (CTAs) to verify the status of projects associated with available earmark balances. In response to the requests from CTAs and sponsors, staff submitted nearly \$5.2 million in earmark balances to Caltrans for repurposing, as detailed in the table below.
