

Procurement Breakdown (MTC) April 1, 2021 - March 31, 2022




- Fluctuations in \$ volume from year to year to be expected due to:

Procurement Breakdown (ABAG) April 1, 2021 - March 31, 2022




- 1st year of ABAG Program




SBE / DBE Commitments (ABAG)

Payments to SBE / DBE Firms (4/1/2021 - 3/31/2022)




- Project delays resulted in a decrease in the % of DBE Payments for this reporting period
