Please advise the committee that I feel strongly that the DTX should be a Level 1 priority for the Bay Area, not Level 2. As a frequent rider of CalTrain, I'm aware of the inconvenience of being dropped off at 4th & King when arriving in San Francisco from the Peninsula.
