College Internship/Mentorship Program

- Seven college mentees for summer of 2022
- Regionally and ethnically diverse students
 - Representation from five Bay Area counties including Alameda, San Francisco, San Mateo, Contra Costa and Solano county.
 - 3 Latinx, 2 Caucasian, 1 African American, 1 Asian.
- Strong survey results from mentees
 - 100% rated their experience as very good or excellent
 - 100% rated their experience with their mentor as very good or excellent
 - 100% said they would recommend the mentorship program to their colleagues
 - Area of consideration from some of the mentees was to make the program longer.


- Double the Applicants and Participants from 2021 pilot

Q14 How did you find out about the Academy?










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Students Deepened knowledge of Bay Area Regional Governments (Entry + Exit Surveys)


Q8 Rate your knowledge on this topic: Bay Area Regional Governments Q5 Rate your knowledge on this topic: Bay Area Regional Governments






Students Deepened Understanding of Equity (Entry + Exit Surveys)

Q9 Rate your knowledge on this topic: Equity




Q6 Rate your knowledge on this topic: Equity
