- 14 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF MOBILITY. THIS MORNING STAFF IS
- 15 RECOMMENDING THE AUTHORITY AMEND RESOLUTION 46 TO BRING THE
- 16 BAIFA THE MEMBERSHIP NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE IN LINE
- 17 WITH AUTHORITIES AT THIS TIME. BAIFA ESTABLISHED THIS
- 18 COMMITTEE THE NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE IN FEBRUARY
- 19 2023. THE COMMITTEE HAS SIX VOTING MEMBERS AND IT FOCUSES ON
- 20 THE TOLL FACILITIES WHERE BAIFA HAS TOLLING AUTHORITY. AND
- 21 THAT'S THE MTC AND BAIFA EXPRESS LANES ON INTERSTATE 680 IN
- 22 CONTRA COSTA COUNTY. ON INTERSTATE 880 IN ALAMEDA COUNTY AND
- 23 ON INTERSTATE 80 IN SOLANO COUNTY. AND ON STATE ROUTE 37 WHICH
- 24 SECURED AUTHORITY FROM THE CALIFORNIA COMMISSION IN MAY 2023.
- 25 THE PURPOSE OF THIS COMMITTEE NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE



- 1 IS TO REVIEW THE OPERATING POLICIES, TOLL RATES, BUDGET FOR
- 2 TOLLING FACILITIES AND USES OF THE TOLL REVENUE FOR THESE
- 3 FACILITIES. THE COMMITTEE REVIEWS IN DETAIL THEN THOSE ITEMS
- 4 COME BEFORE THIS AUTHORITY FOR APPROVAL. IT'S FOCUSED ON THE
- 5 BUSINESS OF THOSE TOLL FACILITIES THAT I MENTIONED. BAIFA DOES
- 6 HAVE A SEPARATE COMMITTEE, A REGIONAL TOLL POLICY COMMITTEE
- 7 THAT IS NOT AFFECTED BY THE AMENDMENT TO THE RESOLUTION I'M
- 8 PROPOSING -- OR RECOMMENDING TODAY. AND THAT COMMITTEE IS A
- 9 FORUM FOR REALLY TALKING ABOUT THE COORDINATION AND
- 10 COLLABORATION AMONG THE TOLL OPERATORS IN THE REGION. SO,
- 11 INCLUDING THE OTHER EXPRESS LANES OPERATED BY ALAMEDA COUNTY
- 12 TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, BY E VTA, FOLKS IN SAN MATEO. THAT'S
- 13 WHERE THAT COORDINATION DISCUSSION TAKES PLACE AND THAT
- 14 COMMITTEE HAS REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH COUNTY. BECAUSE THE
- 15 NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE IS FOCUSED ON THE TOLLING
- 16 BUSINESS WHERE BAIFA HAS DIRECT AUTHORITY, AGAIN IT'S THOSE
- 17 ROADS IN ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA, AND SOLANO COUNTY, THEN STATE
- 18 ROUTE 37. THE NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP
- 19 CONSISTS OF ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH COUNTY THAT HAS A
- 20 TOLL FACILITY THAT'S ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA, AND SOLANO, PLUS
- 21 THE COMMISSIONER REPRESENTING CALSTA AS A NON-VOTING MEMBER.
- 22 AND WHEN BAIFA RESOLUTION 46 WAS FIRST APPROVED, BAIFA HAD NOT
- 23 YET RECEIVED THE AUTHORITY FOR STATE ROUTE 37, AND, SO, IT
- 24 PROVIDED THAT THE CHAIR WOULD APPOINT THREE ADDITIONAL AT-
- 25 LARGE SEATS THAT WOULD THEN BE DESIGNATED FOR THE 37 COUNTIES,



- 1 THE REMAINING 37 COUNTIES, MARIN, SONOMA AND NAPA, AT THE TIME
- 2 THAT TOLLING AUTHORITY WAS GRANTED. HOWEVER, AT THIS TIME, THE
- 3 STATE ROUTE 37 PROJECT CONTINUES TO REALLY WORK ON DESIGN AND
- 4 SECURING FUNDING. AND IT'S REALLY A FEW YEARS OFF FROM THE
- 5 KIND OF BUSINESS THAT WOULD COME BEFORE THE NETWORK AND
- 6 OPERATIONS COMMITTEE AND THE AUTHORITY. AND THE -- SO THAT
- 7 NETWORK AND OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REMAINS VERY FOCUSED AND WILL
- 8 REMAIN VERY FOCUSED FOR THE NEXT FEW YEARS ON THOSE EXPRESS
- 9 LANES IN ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA, AND SOLANO. AS A RESULT, STAFF
- 10 IS RECOMMENDING THE AUTHORITY REVISE RESOLUTION NUMBER 46 TO
- 11 REFLECT THE CONTINUANCE OF THOSE THREE AT-LARGE SEATS UNTIL
- 12 ADOPTION OF THE FIRST STATE ROUTE 37 BUDGET OR TOLL ORDINANCE,
- 13 WHICHEVER COMES FIRST. AND THIS IS JUST REALLY BETTER
- 14 ALIGNMENT WITH WORKLOAD AND THE MATTERS THAT WILL BE COMING
- 15 BEFORE THE COMMITTEE AND THE AUTHORITY IN THE NEXT COUPLE OF
- 16 YEARS.
