Work Project Title:	Wetlands Regional Monitoring Program
Purpose of Project:	Advance a robust regional monitoring program for tidal wetlands in the San Francisco Estuary
Brief Scope of Work:	Build on current work to align the Wetlands Regional Monitoring Program with regulatory needs, build partnerships with community- based organizations and public educational systems, and advance an implementation plan for monitoring activities.
Project Cost Not to Exceed:	\$8,346,022
Funding Source:	US EPA
Fiscal Impact:	Funds programmed in FY24-25
Motion by Committee:	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, to accept an award from and enter into a funding agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the San Francisco Estuary Partnership in an amount of up to \$8,346,022 to advance development of the Wetlands Regional Monitoring Program.
