RM3 Project 25, Richmond-San Rafael Bridge Access Improvements Program – \$5 million to the Bay Area Toll Authority for the Richmond San Rafael Forward Open Road Tolling and I-580 WB HOV Lane Extension Project (RM3 Project #25.4).

RM3 Project 26, North Bay Transit Improvements—1) \$1.04 million to Petaluma Transit for the Petaluma Transit Facility Electrification Project (RM3 Project 26.12); 2) \$0.92 million to Marin Transit for the design phase of Fixed Route Electric Vehicle Charging & Maintenance Facility Project

(RM3 Project 26.13).
