- 14 AIDING OUR JURISDICTIONS, THAT'S GREAT. THAT WAS 2F. THE OTHER
- 15 ONE HERE IS 2H. A CONTRACT KNEE DEEP TIME E MAGAZINE
- 16 PRODUCTION, \$95,000 PART OF SOME 200 AND SOMETHING THOUSAND

- 24 CHAIR, GINA PAPAN: WHEN I WAS TALKING TO STAFF YESTERDAY,
- 25 ONLINE IT SAYS FOURS, AND IN THE HANDOUT, YOU ARE CORRECT.



1 I'LL STICK WITH THE ONE ONLINE THERE SEEMS TO BE SOME 2 DISCREPANCY, THE PRINT-OUT HERE SAYS TWO, SOME OF MY STAFF --WE MADE THAT SAME MISTAKE TOO. 3 4 5 SUE NOACK: I WANT TO GO BACK TO YOUR COMMENT ON SELECTION FOR TRAVEL AND GOING TO DIFFERENT VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AND MISSIONS, 6 7 AS YOU LABELED IT IN YOUR QUESTION. WE SPEND, WHENEVER THESE OPPORTUNITIES COME UP TO SEND COMMISSIONERS, STEPHANIE AND I 8 9 WORK WITH EXECUTIVE STAFF TO TAKE A LOOK AT WHO THE MOST APPROPRIATE PEOPLE ARE TO SEND, WHO MAY NOT HAVE BEEN ABLE TO 10 GO ON A PREVIOUS TRIP, WHERE IT MAKES THE MOST ACCEPTS FROM A 11 12 JURISDICTIONAL POINT OF VIEW, AND, SO, WE GO THROUGH THAT AND MAKE SOME RECOMMENDATIONS AND GO THROUGH THE PROCESS AND ASK 13 FOLKS IF THEY'RE ABLE TO GO, AS WELL. I HAVEN'T BEEN ON ONE 14 YET IN THREE YEARS, INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL, WITH MY SCHEDULE 15 THAT'S JUST NOT SEEMING TO HAPPEN. SO, I JUST WANTED TO -- I'M 16 17 NOT SURE HOW WE CAN MAKE THAT MORE TRANSPARENT AS TO WHEN WE ASK THE SPECIFIC COMMISSIONERS THAT WE THINK IT MAKES SENSE TO 18 GO ON THE TRIP, AND THEN GO DOWN THE LIST AS PEOPLE ARE UNABLE 19 TO GO, THEN WE ASK THE NEXT PERSON UP THAT MAKES THE MOST 20 SENSE. I'M NOT SURE HOW WE CAN MAKE THAT MORE TRANSPARENT THAN 21 22 WHEN WE PUT IT IN FRONT FOR APPROVAL. SO WHEN YOU ARE ASKING 23 FOR TRANSPARENCY I'M JUST NOT SURE HOW THAT WORKS. BECAUSE 24 WE'RE GOING THROUGH A SPECIFIC PROCESS, NOT, SORT OF, A

VOLUNTEER PROCESS, BECAUSE WE KNOW SOME PEOPLE HAVE HAD THE



OPPORTUNITY TO GO BEFORE AND WE WANT TO ALLOW OTHER PEOPLE TO 1 2 DO THAT, SO IT'S NOT A RAISE YOUR HAND AND THEN GO. I'M NOT SURE YOUR QUESTION ON TRANSPARENCY BUT I THINK WE TRY TO MAKE 3 THAT WAY BY BRINGING THE APPROVAL OF WHATEVER THE TRAVEL IS TO 4 5 THE BOARD. 6 7 CHAIR, GINA PAPAN: I THINK MAYBE IN THE FUTURE THE CHAIRS PERMISSION HERE I THINK COMMISSIONERS IF THEY'RE INTERESTED 8 9 MAYBE SHOULD COMMUNICATE THAT TO YOU. I KNOW COMMISSIONER ABE-KOGA IS GOING PARTLY BECAUSE OF VTA BUT ALSO WENT ON A TRIP 10 LAST YEAR. SO, I THINK THAT MIGHT HELP WITH THE COMMISSIONERS 11 12 PROBABLY COMMUNICATING MORE SO. 13 SUE NOACK: SORRY. DIDN'T HAVE IT -- I THINK THE ISSUE WE 14 REALLY WANT TO FOCUS ON THOSE THAT HAVEN'T BEEN ABLE TO TRAVEL 15 THOSE THAT MAKES SENSE FOR JURISDICTIONAL POINT OF VIEW TO THE 16 17 EXTENT WE DON'T HAVE PEOPLE BUT FEEL IT'S IMPORTANT TO GET REPRESENTATIVES THEN WHEN WE ASK ADDITIONAL ONES RATHER THAN 18 19 EVERYBODY RAISE THEIR HAND THEN HAVING TO HAVE A WHOLE LOT OF PEOPLE DISAPPOINTED THAT THEY'RE NOT ABLE TO GO, HOPEFULLY 20 THAT'S TRANSPARENT ENOUGH PROCESS FOR EVERYBODY. SO, THANKS. 21 22 23 CHAIR, GINA PAPAN: AGAIN, I THINK THE COMMISSIONERS 24 COMMUNICATING WITH YOU MIGHT HELP I'M NOT ASKING YOU TO GO

THROUGH THE RAISE YOUR HAND FIRST KIND OF THING. BECAUSE I

- 7 THE BAY AREA REGIONAL COLLABORATIVE IS A LEGISLATIVELY
- 8 MANDATED COMMITTEE MADE UP OF FOUR AGENCIES, MTC, ABAG, BCDC,
- 9 AND THE AIR DISTRICT, TOGETHER THEY WORK ON ITEMS THAT ARE OF
- 10 REGIONAL INTEREST. THE KNEE DEEP TIMES IS ACTUALLY NOT A
- 11 SUBSCRIPTION IT'S ACTUALLY A PUBLICATION THAT REALLY DOES PUT
- 12 OUT THE WORD ON IMPORTANT PLANNING AND RESILIENCY PROJECTS
- 13 AROUND THE REGION. WE SUPPORTED IT FOR A LONG TIME. THE
- 14 CONTRACTS ARE RUN THROUGH MTC, BUT THEY'RE SUPPORTED BY ALL
- 15 FOUR AGENCIES. SO, THERE IS -- THERE IS CONTRIBUTION IN THAT
- 16 WE JUST RUN THE CONTRACT THROUGH US.

- 22 DISTRICT FOR THE MOST PART BUT THEY ARE BY FORMULA.

- 25 KNOW THE STAFF REPORT IS A LITTLE MORE EXPLAINING OF THAT,



THIS PUBLICATION DOES WHAT? THIS IS A LOT OF MONEY. 1 2 ANDREW FREMIER: LIKE I SAID, IT PRODUCES INFORMATION BASED ON 3 VARIOUS RESILIENCY PLANNING AND OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES. 1 CHAIR, GINA PAPAN: OH PUBLIC COMMENT. 2 CLERK OF THE BOARD: ALETA DUPREE PLEASE COME UP NOW CONFIRMING 3 TIME YOU WANT TO PROVIDE WAS TWO MINUTES. 4 5 SPEAKER: GOOD MORNING GINA PAPAN AND MEMBERS. ALETA DUPREE FOR 6 7 THE RECORD SHE AND HER WITH TEAM FOLDS ITEMS OF TECHNICAL LANGUAGE HERE I READ ABOUT DESIGN IMMUNITY FOR STATE ROUTE 37 8 9 INTERESTING SOUNDS LIKE IMMUNIZATION. - 8 SMALL BACKGROUND OF ENGINEERING WOULD HELP US BE EFFICIENT IN
- 9 THE WAY WE PLAN AND REFER DELIVER OUR MEGA PROJECTS. AND I
- 10 WOULD LIKE TO LEARN MORE ABOUT WHAT HAPPENED IN JAPAN WITH THE
- 11 MAG LEFT -- [INDISCERNIBLE] JENKINS -- FOUR MAJOR COMPANIES
- 12 COMPANIES THAT COULD POSSIBLY DELIVER THIS PROJECT AND HOW JR
- 13 WERE ABLE TO GET DOWN TO THE BOTTOM OF THIS AND START

- 16 THE SAME PROBLEMS IN DELIVERY OF MEGA PROJECTS IN THE UNITED

- 1 COUNCIL, SPEAKING ON BEHALF OF MYSELF. I JUST WANT TO RECOUNT
- 2 A SMALL INCIDENT INTERNATIONAL RELATED INCIDENT WHEN I WAS ON
- 3 CITY COUNCIL THAT MAY PROVE USEFUL TO SOME COMMISSIONERS -- I
- 4 HOPE IT DOESN'T -- BUT I HAVE BEEN ON THE COUNCIL FOR ABOUT
- 5 SIX MONTHS AND THERE WAS AN UPCOMING TRIP TO CHINA AND OUR
- 6 COLONEL MEMBERS ENCOURAGED ME TO GO AND SAID IT WOULD BE A
- 7 GREAT THING, AND A FABULOUS JUNKET, AND I SAID NO BECAUSE I
- 8 DIDN'T REALLY THINK THAT I WAS THE RIGHT PERSON TO GO ON THAT
- 9 TRIP. AND, SURE ENOUGH, A FEW WEEKS DOWN THE ROAD, THE SAME
- 10 COUNCIL MEMBER CAME OUT WITH SOMETHING ABSOLUTELY SLAMMING THE
