

The STA Board approved Resolution No. 2023-12 authorizing the allocation request #1 on June 14, 2023. The STA Board was scheduled to approve Resolution No. 2023-12 authorizing allocation request #2 on December 11, 2024.

#### Detailed Project/Subproject Description

As a complement to RM3 allocation #1, the roadway and intersection improvements along Fairgrounds Drive, as well as a new diverging diamond interchange design at the State Route 37 and Fairgrounds Drive of this Project will enhance the transit rider experience, particularly for the regional Solano Express Red Line service, which operates between Suisun City and the El Cerrito del Norte BART Station. Transit and transit-access elements include a bus stop relocation, barrier-protected and wider sidewalks, enhanced pedestrian crossings and new class I and II bike lanes. These funds are allocated from the RM3 North Bay Transit Access Improvements Program.


