2026 Website Support Services Bench

Subject: Staff requests approval of a pre-qualified panel of consultants (“Consultant Bench”) to provide Website Support Services for agency websites, including but not limited to the MTC website (mtc.ca.gov), the ABAG website (abag.ca.gov), 511.org, BayREN, Plan Bay Area, and Vital Signs websites, for a three-year period ending June 30, 2029, with an option to extend for an additional two-year period. The recommended firms and service categories are listed in Attachment A.

Background:

In 2020, MTC issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to establish a pre-qualified panel of consultants to provide On-Call Website Operations, Maintenance, and Improvement Services to support agency websites for the fiscal years 2020 through 2026. As a result of the RFQ, MTC established a bench consisting of twenty firms to perform website services. The resulting bench contracts will expire on June 30, 2026.

Procurement Process:

On February 23, 2026, MTC issued a RFQ for Website Support Services. The RFQ contained two service categories, or areas of expertise, in which firms were invited to submit qualifications:

- A. Website Operations and Maintenance Services; and
- B. Website Design, Development, and Enhancement Services.

Proposers were invited to submit for either or both service categories.

On March 31, 2026, 23 Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) were received. All 23 firms submitted the required documents necessary to evaluate their SOQs. A panel of MTC Sustainable Mobility & Operations (SUMO) and Legislation and Public Affairs (LPA) staff (the “Evaluation Panel”) evaluated the SOQs against the Desired Qualifications based on the following Evaluation Criteria specified in the RFQ, as listed below in descending order of importance:

- 1. Experience & Qualifications of Firms & Proposed Staff (60%)
- 2. Reasonableness of Rates (25%)

3. Presentation (15%)
(100%)

Each criterion was scored with a total possible score of 100.

Based on the results of the evaluation, the Evaluation Panel recommended that 18 of the 23 firms be on the bench for their respective service categories, as listed in Attachment A to this summary sheet. All selected firms demonstrated strong project management skills, identified qualified key staff with relevant project experience, and demonstrated expertise in one or more of the website-related consulting services described in the service categories for which they were selected.

Award of a contract with one of the pre-qualified consultants may take place by direct selection or via mini-procurement, pursuant to MTC's procurement procedures. Attachment B to this summary sheet includes a list of the recommended firms and their small business enterprise status.

Contracts resulting from the Consultant Bench provide technical support for and a comprehensive understanding of compliance to Section 508 of the Federal Rehabilitation Act, which are essential to ensure that all agency websites meet the accessibility standards set forth by Section 508. Contracts resulting from the Consultant Bench also provide technical support for compliance with the Brown Act of the California Government Code. Continued technical support for the abovementioned federal and state requirements is a critical sequential element of ongoing work. Additionally, the continued operations, maintenance, hosting, and security management of the agency websites are critical sequential elements of ongoing work.

Issues:

None identified.

Recommendations:

- Staff recommends that this Committee approve the pre-qualified panel of consultants ("Consultant Bench") as listed in Attachment A, 2026 Website Support Services - List of Firms and Service Categories, to provide Website Support Services for a three-year period ending June 30, 2029, with an option to extend for an additional two-year period. Funding will become available in each fiscal year, subject to approval of MTC annual

budgets. Staff will return to the Administration Committee or to the appropriate Committee for authorization of any contracts exceeding the Executive Director's signature authority.
