# **HIP Background**

#### **Key Features**

- Adopted in October 2018 as an incentive for jurisdictions to produce/preserve affordable housing in Growth Geographies
- \$71 million for top 15 jurisdictions
  - \$53 million regional One Bay Area Grant (OBAG 2) funds
  - \$18 million local funds (swap)
- Awarded on per-unit basis for progress between 2018 and 2022




### **HIP Awards**

#### Timeline

- October 2018: HIP program adopted
- December 2023: draft awards adopted
- March 2024: awards finalized with data updates
- April-December 2024: rolling call for projects
- December 2024 April 2025: project selection

#### **Housing Units and HIP Awards**





# **HIP Recommendations**

#### **Highlights**

- This month's recommended action completes OBAG 2 HIP programming
  - \$23.5 million recommended for 12 projects in 9 cities
- Projects support shared local and regional priorities
  - Fix-it-first rehabilitation
  - Safety enhancements
  - Active transportation facilities
  - Transit improvements
