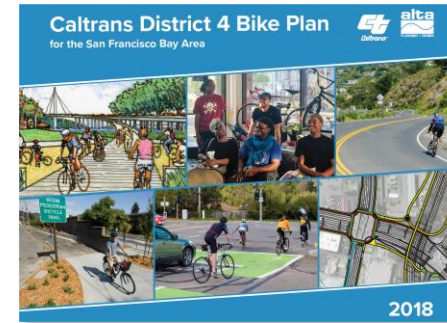

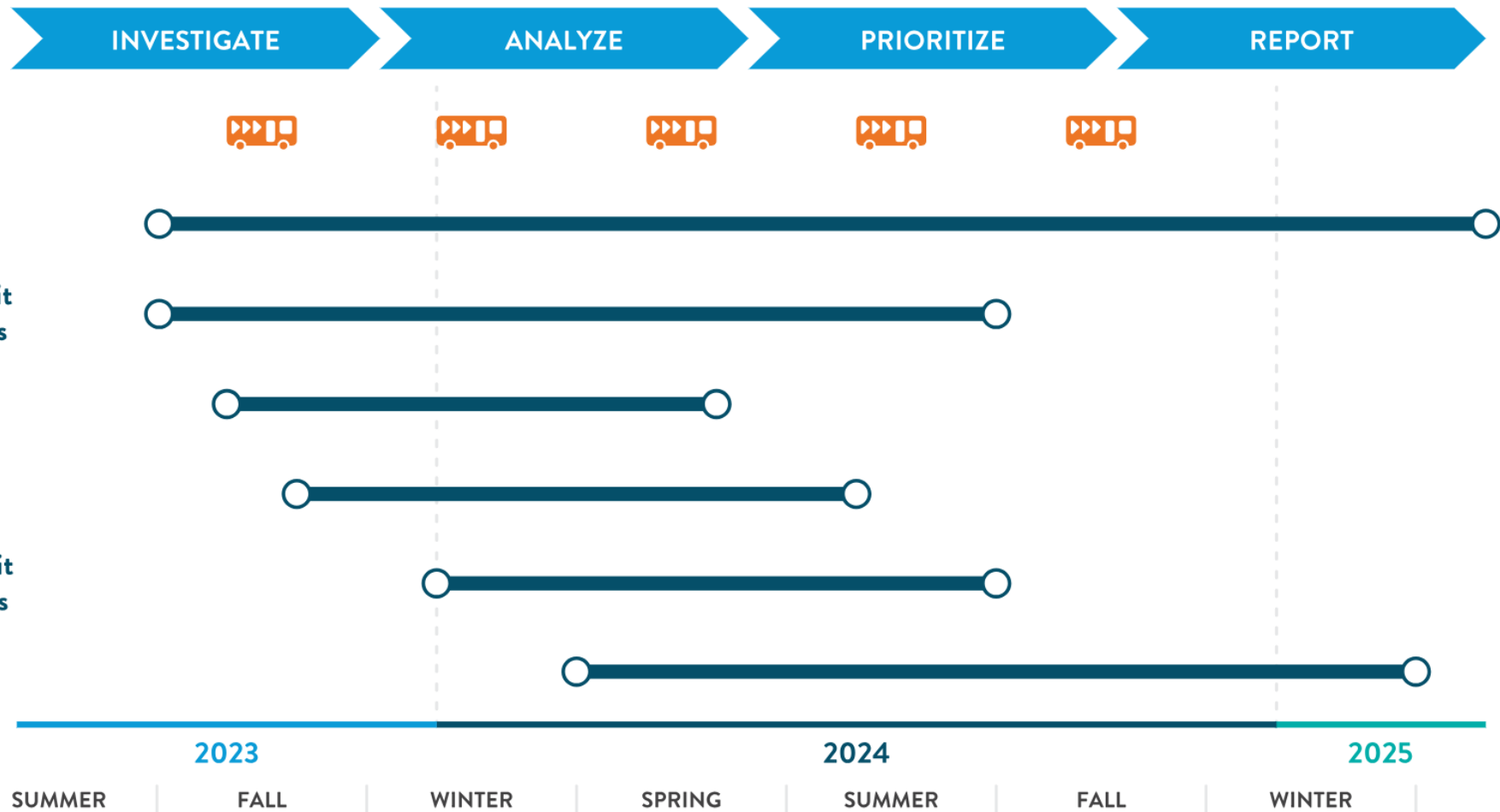

Transit Plan Outcome: Location-based Needs

- Based in part on D4 Bike Plan framework
- Transit Priority Needs
- Transit Access Needs
- Prioritized – example metrics:
 - Transit frequency
 - Transit ridership
 - Equity Priority Communities
 - Presence of ped/bike infrastructure
 - Transit speeds and bottlenecks



D4 Bike Plan prioritized needs

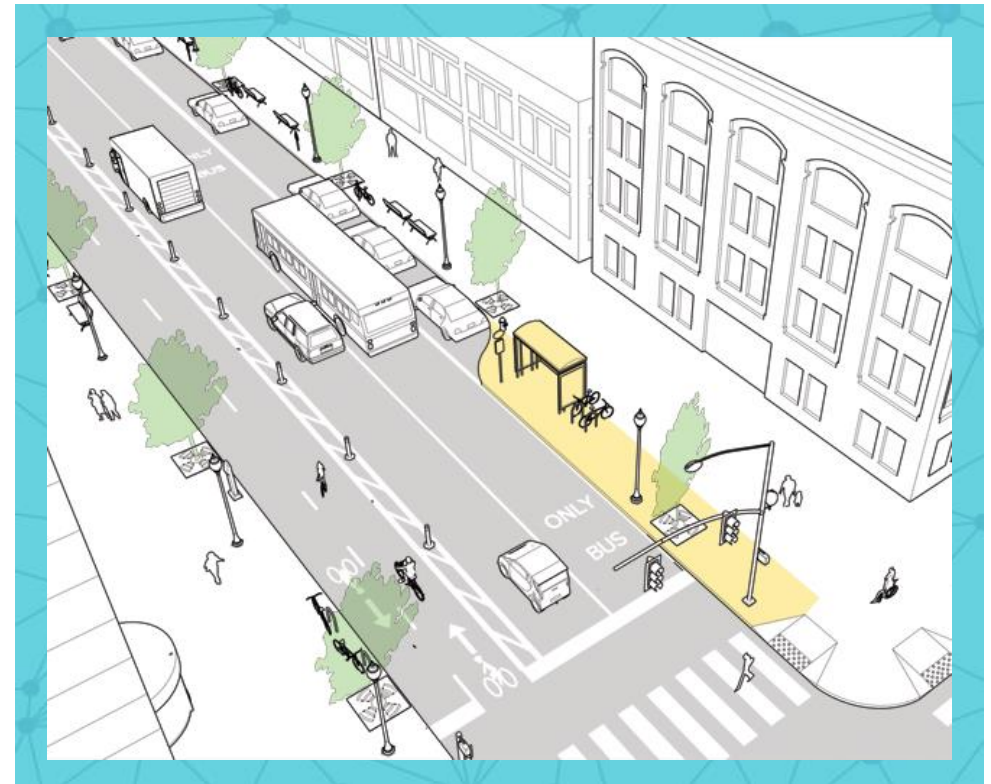
Transit Best Practices Toolkit

Transit Priority Improvements (examples)

- Dedicated transit lanes
- Transit signal priority
- Managed lanes (HOT, reversible, part-time)
- Queue jump lanes
- Bus stop relocations

Transit Access Improvements (examples)

- Bus bulbs/islands
- Bikeways, sidewalks, crosswalks
- Bus stop amenities
- Wayfinding



Other Strategies to Support Transit in District 4

- **Transit Policy** – Support the development and implementation of Caltrans Transit Policy
- **Planning and project delivery** – Improve transparency and predictability, opportunities to streamline
- **Performance measures** – Monitor transit priority implementation on the State Highway System
- **Staffing up**
 - Build up transit planning function
 - Point-of-contact for transit agencies
 - Engagement to support transit equity
