



Bay Area Housing Finance Authority (BAHFA) FY 2025-26 Ongoing Projects & Deliverables

- Doorway Housing Portal
 - Online portal to find and apply for affordable housing
- Priority Sites Loan Program
 - 1,600 new affordable homes across 10 projects
- Preservation Pilot Program
 - Initial 2 loans closed with community land trusts; remaining ~\$9 million available now via open Notice of Funding Availability

Napa Rental Assistance Pilot

 Multiyear rent subsidies to prevent homelessness of rent-burdened seniors

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- The one-time grant allocation is projected to be fully expended by FY 2026–27
- Regional Early Action Planning 2.0: \$34.5 million grant (2 pilot projects)
 - Transferred from the MTC
- TOAH Exchange funding for rental assistance \$5 million
