Toll Increase and Changes to High Occupancy Vehicle Policies for BATA Bridges.

A request for the referral of BATA Resolution 184, Toll Schedule for the State-Owned Toll Bridges in the Bay Area to the Authority for approval. This Resolution would increase toll rates over a five-year period starting January 1, 2026 to fund toll bridge operations and preservation and establish a uniform three-person carpool requirement for discounted tolls on all bridges.
