THERE IS A LOT GOING ON IN THE TOLL SPACE, TRYING TO KEEP UP WITH IT ALL AND OUR EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION 18 19 WITH OTHER SYSTEMS. THERE IS AN INTERESTING PARADOX THAT I SEE 20 IN THAT WE WANT TO HAVE VEHICLES ON OUR BRIDGES, BECAUSE THEY PROVIDE REVENUE. BUT YET WHEN YOU HAVE TOO MANY VEHICLES, YOU 21 22 HAVE CONGESTION. WHERE IS THAT FINE LINE? ESPECIALLY WHEN I 23 CONSIDER THAT WE ARE STILL RECOVERING FROM A PANDEMIC, AND 24 CONGESTION MANAGEMENT BECOMES MORE IMPORTANT AS WE HOPE TO HAVE AN INCREASE ON BRIDGE TRAFFIC. BUT YET, I ALSO FEEL THAT 25



- 1 PEOPLE MORE AND MORE SHOULD BE GETTING BACK ON PUBLIC
- 2 TRANSPORTATION, SUCH AS USING BART UNDER THE BAY, OR THE
- 3 FERRIES, ALSO PLAY A PART, AND VARIOUS BUS SERVICES THAT GO
- 4 OVER THE BRIDGE AND THE BUSES DON'T PAY TOLLS TO GO OVER THE
- 5 BRIDGES, AT LEAST PUBLIC TRANSIT ONES. I CAN'T SPEAK FOR,
- 6 LIKE, THE INTERCITY BUSES, OR -- I THINK THE CHARTER BUSES DO
- 7 PAY. WE HAVE A LOT OF WORK TO DO TO PAY FOR IT WITH BRIDGE
- 8 TOLLS. AND WE HAVE TO REMEMBER THE IMPORTANCE OF WHY WE
- 9 COLLECT THESE BRIDGE TOLLS, AND WE HAVE TO COLLECT THESE
- 10 BRIDGE TOLLS. IT'S TO KEEP OUR SYSTEM SAFE. THANK YOU.
