Contracts - Local Public Fleet Electrification Planning Technical Assistance Consulting Services with ICF Incorporated, L.L.C., doing business in the State of California as ICF Consulting, L.L.C (\$1,000,000); Optony, Inc. (\$900,000); Willdan Energy Solutions (\$900,000); AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (\$500,000); Guidehouse Inc. (\$400,000); and NV5 Consultants, Inc. (formerly known as Sage Renewable Energy Consulting, Inc. DBA NV5) (\$400,000)

#### Subject:

Authorization to negotiate and enter into contracts with ICF Incorporated, L.L.C., doing business in the State of California as ICF Consulting, L.L.C. in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000, Optony, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$900,000, Willdan Energy Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$900,000, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$500,000, Guidehouse Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, and NV5 Consultants Inc. (formerly known as Sage Renewable Energy Consulting, Inc. DBA NV5) in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 to provide services for Local Public Fleet Electrification Planning Technical Assistance. These planning projects advance Plan Bay Area 2050 strategies to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by helping local governments and agencies plan the transition of their fleets to zero emission vehicles.

#### **Background:**

On April 14, 2023, as part of a set of Transportation Electrification Initiatives, the Joint MTC Planning Committee with the ABAG Administrative Committee approved \$10 million to help local public agencies develop plans to transition their fleets to zero emission vehicles. In early 2024, MTC solicited a call for applications from local agencies for fleet planning technical assistance. On April 12, 2024, the Joint MTC Planning Committee with the ABAG Administrative Committee up to \$6 million to provide technical assistance to 32 public agencies that applied for support. Through these projects, each of the participating agencies will receive consultant support to analyze their public fleets, identify zero-emission replacement options, assess the necessary charging infrastructure, and develop transition plans.

### Procurement

On November 12, 2024, MTC issued a Mini Request for Proposals (Mini-RFP) for firms on the 2023 Transportation Electrification Planning and Technical Assistance Consultant Bench under Service Category B: Fleet Electrification Planning to provide local public fleet electrification planning technical assistance consultant services for six groups ("Projects") of participating agencies (the 32 participating agencies are grouped by geography and a consultant will be assigned to provide fleet planning for all of the agencies within a given group). On November 20, 2024, MTC hosted a virtual Pre-Submittal Conference that was attended by 36 firms. By the deadline on December 17, 2024, MTC received 101 qualified proposals across all of the project groupings from 22 firms.

The proposals were evaluated by a panel of MTC staff against the following evaluation criteria:

- 1. Qualifications and Team Experience (45%)
- 2. Price (20%)
- 3. Cost Effectiveness (15%)
- 4. Understanding and Approach to the Project (15%)
- 5. Presentation (5%)

After a review of the proposals, the evaluation panel recommends the selection of the firms for each Project for contracts not to exceed the amounts listed in Table 1.
