SO, AS I SPEAK ABOUT BATA OVERSIGHT, IN GENERAL, I'M STEEPED IN THIS RIGHT NOW -- WELL, NOT AT THIS MOMENT, BECAUSE 17 I'M NORTH OF 60th STREETS. BUT I AM IN THE CONGESTION ZONE IN 18 NEW YORK CITY A LOT. AND I'M USING BUSES, SOMEWHAT, IN NEW 19 YORK CITY, BUT MOSTLY I'M USING THE SUBWAY. SO WHY DO I SPEAK 20 21 OF NEW YORK. WE DO SIMILAR WORK WITH BATA, MANAGING OF TOLLS AND COLLECTIONS. AND THIS IS NOT JUST ABOUT COLLECTING MONEY 22 FOR BRIDGES, BUT THERE IS SOME CONGESTION MANAGEMENT ASPECTS 23 OF THIS. I THINK I CAN CERTAINLY SAY IN NEW YORK THAT, 24

GENERALLY FOUND THE BUSES TO BE FASTER OUT ON THE STREETS.
