MTC Resolution No. 4646, Revised 2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment 2025-15

Subject:

2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment 2025-15 - Revised since the Programming and Allocations Committee meeting on July 9, 2025.

Background:

At the Programming and Allocations Committee meeting on July 9, 2025, staff proposed a revision to the 2025 TIP, TIP Revision 2025-15, with the request that the Committee forward the revision to the Commission for approval. Subsequent to the Committee meeting, staff received a request from Eastern Contra Costa County Transit Authority's (ECCTA) to add an additional project change to the revision. Updating the TIP revision to include the proposed changes to ECCTA's Bus Fueling Station project in this revision facilitates the delivery of ECCTA's Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Buses and Bus Facilities Section 5339 discretionary grant that is subject to lapse on September 30, 2025. Staff-level discussions between ECCTA and FTA indicate that the proposed scope change for this project may be approved within the parameters of the Buses and Bus Facilities discretionary program, and FTA staff have recommended that this updated scope be added to the 2025 TIP so that the project grant can be reviewed and obligated prior to the funds lapsing at the end of the federal fiscal year.

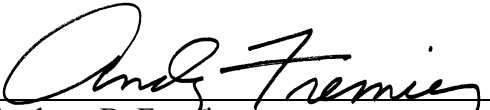
