Membership	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 Members from the MTC ABAG Community Advisory Council (<i>change from 10 Policy Advisory Council members for 2023-2025 term</i>)• 6 Members from Transit Operators' public advisory boards (staff recommend 4 members from large operators and 2 members from small operators) (<i>new</i>)• 9 Members from customer interests:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3 from policy organizations (<i>change from 4</i>)• 1 from transit rider group• 1 from students/youth (<i>change from 2</i>)• 1 from business• 1 from city transportation or public works department (<i>change to include "or public works"</i>)• 1 from disability community• 1 at-large seat (<i>new</i>)
Chair/Vice-Chair	Chair and Vice Chair may be selected by a majority vote of the CAG from any duly serving member of the CAG.
