- RM3 Project 22, Interstate 80 Westbound Truck Scales \$69 million to STA for the construction phase and an allocation amendment to rescind \$4.5 million in RM3 funds from the right of way phase of the I-80 Westbound Truck Scales project (RM3 Project 22).
