5 EVERYONE. SO GLAD TO BE HERE. IT CHALLENGE BEING A CHAIR FOR
6 ANYTHING ARE MANY. AS I LEARNED FROM MY TEETH, FROM MY HAND

16 **JOHNNY PARKER:** GOOD MORNING THANK YOU FOR TAKING THE TIME TO
17 LISTEN TO TO INTRO. VICE CHAIR OBSERVED ROLE THAT WE PLAY IN
18 ADVISING MTC PUSHING FOR DISSEVER IF I AND SOCIAL EQUITY.
19 BEING A PERSON OF COLOR AND LIVING WITH DISABILITIES,
20 ACCUMULATED DURING MILITARY SERVICE, (DIVERSITY (UNDERSTOOD
21 NEED FOR PROMOTING MORE REPRESENTATION IN THE FIELD OF
22 TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING AND OVERALL BETTER ENVIRONMENT FOR
23 THOSE IN NEED. AND THOSE WHO ARE UNDER-SERVED. I ALSO LOOK
24 FORWARD TO WORKING WITH MEMBERS OF EQUITY & ACCESS COMMITTEE
25 AS WELL AS CHAIR OF THE POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE. TO MAKE

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1 **TERRY SCOTT:** I APPRECIATE THE WORK HE HAS DONE AND PREVIOUS
2 YEAR. AS VICE CHAIR. AND LOOK FORWARD TO THE FUTURE FOR OUR
3 EQUITY AND ACCESS SUBCOMMITTEE. THANK YOU.

4

5 **JOHNNY PARKER:** ANY OTHER COMMENTS? EITHER ONLINE OR IN PERSON?
6 NOT SEEING. YES, GO AHEAD. DIANE.

7

8 **SPEAKER:** MY FIRST MEETING IN THE SUBCOMMITTEE. LIKE A LITTLE
9 CONTEXT. HOW MUCH TIME HAVE BOTH CURRENT CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR
10 SERVED? JUST WANT TO A LITTLE BIT OF CONTEXT. THANK YOU. (.

14 **JOHNNY PARKER, JR.:** YOU CAN CORRECT ME BOTH SERVED EXACT SAME
15 AMOUNT OF TIME. TURNED THE LEADERSHIP POSITIONS WITH EACH
16 OTHER. IS THAT RIGHT?

17

18 **JOHNNY PARKER:** THAT IS CORRECT. BOTH CHAIR CHRISTINE
19 FITZGERALD AND I WERE IN A POSITION WHERE NO ONE WANTED TO BE
20 IN THIS POSITION. SO WE BOTH RAISED OUR HAND TO KIND OF KEEP
21 THINGS ROLLING.

22

23 **KY-NAM MILLER:** I CAN PROVIDE LOGISTICAL CONTEXT FOR THE VOTE
24 THAT'S GOING TO TAKE PLACE. IF THAT'S ALL RIGHT WITH YOU.
25 EVERY SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBER HAVE TO STATE THEIR PREFERENCE, BY



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1 EITHER SAYING NAME OF THEM PREFERRED CANDIDATE OR ABSTAINING
2 FROM THE VOTE. WINNING CANDIDATE IS GETS 50% PLUS ONE MARTHA
3 AND I COUNT 7 VOTING MEMBERS. MAGIC NUMBER IS FOUR. IF NO
4 CANDIDATE WINS WE'LL HAVE A ANOTHER ROUND AND ALLOW THE
5 CANDIDATE TO MAKE FURTHER STATEMENTS. OR I CANDIDATE IN THAT
6 EVENT MAY ALSO REMOVE THEMSELVES FROM THE VOTE. AND WITH THAT,
7 ARE THERE ANY OTHER QUESTIONS BEFORE WE? YES, ANNA?

8

9 **SPEAKER:** THANK YOU. I HAVE GREAT RESPECT FOR BOTH OF OUR CHAIR
10 AND VICE CHAIR. AND IS THIS ACTUALLY A REALLY DIFFICULTER
11 DECISION.

12

13 **ANNE OLIVIA ELDRED:** HAVE A QUESTION FOR BOTH OF YOU ABOUT HOW,
14 THINGS HAVE BEEN GOING THE LAST YEAR. AND LIKE HOW THAT SPLIT
15 OF LABOR HAS BEEN GOING AND I MEAN, LIKE WHAT IS YOUR ANALYSIS
16 OF HOW THE LAST YEAR WENT?

17

18 **V. CHAIR, JOHNNY PARKER, JR.:** I THINK THE LAST YEAR WENT OKAY.
19 I JUST WISH THAT WE HAD A LITTLE BIT MORE BOOTS ON THE GROUND.
20 THAT'S WHY I MENTIONED OUTREACH. LIKE JUST RECENTLY, WE HAVE
21 BEEN INVITED TO A CONVENTION AND IT THINGS LIKE THAT I WANT
22 AND TO BE A LITTLE BIT MORE INVOLVED IN. ALSO, ABOUT WE'RE
23 INVITED TO ANY KIND OF OUTREACH, WHERE WHICH CAN PUT A LITTLE
24 BIT MORE PINPOINTING ON THE THINGS THAT ARE DEALING WITH WHAT
25 WE'RE DISABILITY HAS BEEN LACKING, WITH TRANSPORTATION, WE



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1 DON'T GET TO SEE THAT FOCUS AND WE CAN PINPOINT IT A LITTLE
2 BIT MORE, ADDRESS IT A LITTLE BIT MORE, FROM OUR PERSPECTIVE,
3 ALSO, WITH EQUITY AND WITH HOUSING. WE DON'T DO THAT A LOT.
4 AND I AM FORTUNATE TO BE IN A POSITION WITH MY EMPLOYER ALLOW
5 ME TO GET OUT DO THINGS LIKE THAT. I NEED NEED TO DO THIS FOR
6 MTC WITH POLICY AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE. ANDS I CAN DO THAT. SO
7 HOPEFULLY, OR EVEN IN MY CURRENT ROLE, I'LL BE ABLE TO DO THAT
8 A LITTLE BIT MORE.

9

10 **KY-NAM MILLER:** CHRIS?

11

12 **CHAIR, CHRISTINE FITZGERALD:** SURE HAVE OPINION MANY CHALLENGES
13 AND I WILL ADMITTED, BEING REMOTE, ALL THE TIME, IS KIND OF
14 TOUGH KIND OF A CHALLENGE AT THE SAME TIME, THOUGH, EVEN WHEN
15 I'VE SEEN AND HEARD FROM NOT ONLY MEMBERS OF THEM COMMITTEE,
16 BUT THE ECONOMY EYE MELS AT LARGE -- MEMBERS COMMITTEE MEMBERS
17 AT LARGE, THEIR EXPERIENCES, I MAY NOT BE BOOTS ON THE GROUND
18 ALL THE TIME, I CAN, I DO HAVE MY OTHER TO AEAR TO THE RAIL IF
19 YOU WILL, . THINKING OF INFORMATION AS I GO ALONG ADD WHERE I
20 CAN, I DO BRING IT BACK IN IT SOME FORM OR FUNCTION. I LOOK
21 FORWARD TO CONTINUING TO PUT ON EQUITY & ACCESS FORWARD IN ALL
22 WAYS POSSIBLE. ENDS GIVEN ESPECIALLY GIVEN CLIMATE RIGHT NOW.
23 IT IS A CHALLENGE. BUT IT IS VERY NECESSARY.

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1 **KY-NAM MILLER:** THANK YOU FOR THAT. SUBCOMMITTEE GOOD, UNMUTE
2 YOURSELF AND WE'LL GO TO YOU SUBCOMMITTEE.

3

4 **WILLIAM GOODWIN:** LIMITED OBSERVATION, OF BOTH COUNCILMEMBERS
5 CHRISTINE FITZGERALD AND COUNCILMEMBER JOHNNY PARKER, THEY
6 HAVE WORKED WELL AS CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR OF THIS SUBCOMMITTEE.
7 AND IT WOBBLING COMFORTING TO KNOW THAT WHOEVER IS NOTE VOTED
8 CHAIR HERE, WILL PUT THEIR NAME IN THE HAT FOR VICE CHAIR. AND
9 SO WE WOULD CONTINUE THAT RELATIONSHIP AND THAT LEADERSHIP
10 THAT THEY BOTH PROVIDED. THANK YOU.

11

12 **KY-NAM MILLER:** THANK YOU. SUBCOMMITTEE WONG? WONG GOOD
13 CANDIDATES. DIFFICULTY DECISIONS, LIKE TO HAVE THE CANDIDATES
14 AGAIN REMIND US WHAT THE COUNTIES OR REGIONS THEY REPRESENT.

15

16 **HOWARD WONG:** AND WHAT CONSISTENCY GROUP AND ALSO HOW WOULD YOU
17 WORK WITH WITH OTHER AREAS OF THE BAY AREA?

18

19 **CHAIR, CHRISTINE FITZGERALD:** FIRST WANT TO GO FIRST?

20

21 **V. CHAIR, JOHNNY PARKER, JR.:** UP THER I AM CURRENTLY, WITH
22 SOLA IN. O COUNTY REPRESENTING PEOPLE OF COLOR. SOLANO COUNTY.
23 I HAVE BEEN WORK OING WITH A LOT OF DISABILITIES, OS WITHIN
24 SOLNANO COUNTY. HAS TO DO WITH MY ROLE WITH THE PUBLIC
25 LIBRARY. WHICH FIRST GOT HIRED WITH THE PUBLIC LIBRARY.



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1 BECAUSE OF MY BEING REGISTERED AS A VETERAN WITH DISABILITIES.
2 HAD ME DO A LOT OF WORK WITH SOME ORGANIZATIONS. SO BUT ALSO,
3 BECAUSE I'VE BEEN GOING KIND OF BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN SOLANO
4 AND SONOMA RELOCATING TO SONOMA STARTED WITH SONOMA COUNTY
5 VETERANS ORGANIZATION AND HOPING TO STREAMLINE INTO CIVILIAN
6 DISABILITY ORGANIZATIONS AS WELL. JUST STARTING OFF.

7

8 **CHAIR, CHRISTINE FITZGERALD:** VERY GOOD. SO GLAD TO HAVE YOU
9 DOING WHAT YOU'RE DOING. MY BACKGROUND IS HERE SANTA CLARA
10 COUNTY. ST. CLAIRE COUNTY CITIZEN ALL MY LIFE. SAN A CLAY IRA
11 UNDERSTAND THE AREA. MULTIPLE DISABILITIES, WORKING
12 ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE WORKED WITH PEOPLE IN MULTIPLE
13 DISABILITIES, AND CERTAINLY, HEARING THE CONSTITUENCY, MY
14 CONSTITUENCY OF MULTIPLE PEOPLE AND FAMILIES WITH MEMBER THAT
15 IS DISABILITIES PARENT AND CHILDREN, YOU GET TO HEAR
16 INTERESTING STORES BOTH GOOD AND BAD. STORIES WHAT IS GOING
17 ON IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY. THAT DOES NOT MEAN THAT I DO NOT
18 HAVE CONTACT WITH OTHER COUNTIES. I JUST KNOW MY COUNTY
19 EXTREMELY WELL. CURRENTLY I'M WORKING WITH ORGANIZATION MOVE
20 ON BAY AREA. TO PUT OUT A CONFERENCE IN SOLANO AT THE, NAPA
21 VALLEY JUNIOR COLLEGE. PRETTY FAR NORTH. BUT AT THE SAME TIME,
22 WE'RE WORKING ON OUR WAY AROUND THE GREAT BAY AREA. WE WILL BE
23 HAVING CONFERENCES THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE AREA. ALL SEVEN, SIX,
24 SERVE COUNTIES IN THE AREA. SIX, SEVEN COUNTIES. LIKE JOHNNY
25 GET TO HEAR A LOT, EXAMPLES OF WHAT PEOPLE ARE GOING THROUGH



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1 THE THROUGH THROUGH BOTH IF TRANSPORTATION AND HOUSING AND WE
2 NEED MORE HOUSING. WE NEED MORE CONSTRUCTIVE AS UNIFIED
3 TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS. FOR SHALL. EVERYBODY SO PEOPLE CAN BE
4 ACTIVE IN THEIR LIVES A IN SO MANY DIFFERENT WAYS. THAT'S MY
5 STORY AND I'M STICKING TO IT.
