

What is an ERP?

- Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP)
 System: a software platform that integrates various business functions (such as finance, HR, contracts, projects, grants) into one complete system
- Central feature is a shared database
 - Employees in different sections can rely on the same information

ERP Program Key Accomplishments Since May 2025

Phase 2A Configure & Confirm Stage


- Extracted, transformed, and migrated HR, Finance, and Purchasing data into Oracle to support testing and data validation.
- Developed a training strategy and plan to prepare staff for adopting new processes and Oracle.
- Clarified future operations with process maps that streamline Finance, Procurement, HR, and Project & Grant management.
- Confirmed Oracle configurations align with MTC's business needs, reducing risk of rework and delays.
- Strengthened change readiness by engaging leaders, mobilizing 27 change champions, and keeping staff informed.
- Adjusted the program schedule after Gate 1 review, ensuring program progresses toward a realistic go live date.
- Launched system testing with a clear strategy, accelerating progress toward user acceptance and adoption.

Phase 2B Compose

- Non-core HR Oracle implementation launched and is on schedule.
- Engaged staff as subject matter experts (SMEs) to collect business requirements.
- Prepared current-state process maps to highlight improvement opportunities.

Budget Planning (EPM)

- Finalized scope and schedule to provide clarity and alignment.
- Loaded budgets and actuals into Oracle to enable accurate financial management.
- Configured planning budgets in Oracle to improve forecasting and resource allocation.
