| Project Cost Not to Exceed: | Existing contract: \$1,335,000 Proposed amendment: \$216,019 Updated not to exceed: \$1,551,019 |
| Funding Source: | PG&E (ratepayer funds) as directed by the CPUC |
| Fiscal Impact: | Funds programmed in FY 25-26 and FY26-27 Budgets |
| Motion by Committee: | The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, to enter into a contract amendment with DiLytics, Inc. for the Data Aggregation and Reporting Tool in order to extend the contract by one year to December 31, 2026 and to add \$216,019, for a total contracted amount not to exceed \$1,555,019. |
