DO WE HAVE A STAFF REPORT? YES. 17 JAMES GO: GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. MY NAME IS JAMES BATA 18 STAFF PRESENTING THE TWO ITEMS RELATED TO THE REGIONAL TOLLING 19 INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE SERVICES CONTRACT. I KNOW IT'S A 20 MOUTHFUL OF THE TITLE BUT AT SOME POINT WE'LL COME UP WITH AN 21 ACRONYM. THIS CONTRACT IS WITH YUNEX LLC GENERAL SCOPE OF THIS 22 CONTRACT PROVIDES MAINTENANCE SERVICES ON EQUIPMENT THAT 23

SUPPORT TOLLING OPERATIONS AT THE SEVEN STATE OWNED FACILITIES

AS WELL AS CIVIL INFRASTRUCTURE AND ROADSIDE EQUIPMENT ON THE

- 1 130 LANE MILES OF MAINTENANCE FREEWAY EXPRESS LANES ALONG
- 2 CONTINUING PROVIDING MAINTENANCE SERVICES -- THAT BETA BATA
- 3 AND BAIFA MANAGING UNDER TWO SEPARATE CONTRACTS STAFF HAS
- 4 ELECTED TO COMBINE THESE TWO CONTRACTS INTO ONE SINGLE
- 5 CONTRACT. THE CONTRACT WILL PERFORM MAINTENANCE INSPECTION AND
- 6 PERFORM ON CALL SERVICES TO ENSURE ASSETS ARE OPERATIONAL AND
- 7 TO RESPOND TO ANY EMERGENCY REPAIRS. THE CONTRACT WILL PERFORM
- 8 IMMEDIATE AND CORRECTIVE REPAIRS TO NEGOTIATE TASK ORDERS THAT
- 9 WILL BE CAREFULLY REVIEWED BY STAFF. EXAMPLES OF THESE REPAIRS
- 10 INCLUDE COSTLY FIBEROPTIC REPAIRS, EQUIPMENT MALFUNCTIONS,
- 11 VEHICULAR KNOCK DOWNS AND VANDALISM. TOTAL COST OF 16.5
- 12 MILLION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ON AVERAGE THIS IS ABOUT
- 13 5.5 MILLION PER YEAR AND IS SPLIT BETWEEN THE BATA BRIDGE TOLL
- 14 FACILITIES AND BAIFA MAIN EXPRESS LANES CONTRACT ALSO PROVIDES
- 15 ABILITY TO PERFORM AS NEEDED WORK ON REGIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE
- 16 THAT'S OWNED OR OPERATED BY MTC, OR MTC SAFE, HOWEVER NO WORK
- 17 IS ANTICIPATED YET BUT CAN BE PERFORMED THROUGH NEGOTIATED
- 18 TASK ORDERS. AFTER PROCUREMENT PROCESS THAT STARTED IN
- 19 FEBRUARY 2ND PROPOSALS WERE RECEIVED AND UPON REVIEW OF
- 20 PROPOSALS THE EVALUATION PANEL RECOMMENDED UNIX, LLC TO BE
- 21 AWARDED THIS CONTRACT BASED ON THEIR PROJECT APPROACH
- 22 COMMITMENT PROVIDING HIGHLY EXPERIENCED AND QUALIFIED TEAM AND
- 23 THEIR ABILITY TO DELIVER THE CONTRACT WITHIN THE BUDGETED
- 24 AMOUNT. MOVING ON TO THE SECOND ITEM RELATED TO THIS CONTRACT,
- 25 SINCE BATA WILL BE THE LEAD AGENCY TO ADMINISTER THIS



1	CONTRACT, WE ARE SEEKING APPROVAL FOR BATA TO ENTER INTO A
2	COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH BAIFA, MTC, AND MTC SAFE TO
3	DELEGATE THE CONTRACT RESPONSIBILITY TO BATA AND ALSO TO
4	DOCUMENT EACH AGENCY'S ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. SIMILAR
5	ITEMS WERE REQUESTED AND APPROVED AT THE MOST RECENT BAIFA AND
6	MTC OPERATIONS COMMITTEES. IN CONCLUSION, STAFF IS REQUESTING
7	APPROVAL OF THESE TWO ITEMS PRESENTED IN ORDER TO PROVIDE A
8	DEPENDABLE 21724/7 DAY-TO-DAY MAINTENANCE CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE
9	ASSETS AND EQUIPMENT SUPPORTING TOLL OPERATIONS REMAIN
10	OPERATIONAL. HAPPY TO TAKE ANY QUESTIONS.
