RE: <u>Clipper<sup>®</sup> Contract Change Order – Means-Based Pilot Program: Cubic Transportation</u> Systems, Inc. (\$1,000,000)

### **Background**

For most Bay Area households, transportation is the third-largest monthly expense—trailing only the cost of housing and food. In 2015, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) launched a study to determine if a transit reduced fare program based on household income would be feasible and effective.

As a result of the study and in consultation with transit operators, the Commission approved the launch of the Regional Means-Based Transit Fare Pilot Program ("Pilot Program") in May 2018. MTC and the transit operators committed to making the discount available only through Clipper via the "Clipper Coupon," which is the working name of the Means-Based Transit Fare Discount product on the Clipper card. The Pilot Program is expected to launch publicly in the fall of 2019.

### **Pilot Program Elements**

- 1. *Eligibility*: Adults who earn up to 200% of the Federal Poverty Line (approximately \$50,000 per year for a family of four) can receive the transit discount.
- 2. *Availability on Clipper*: Pilot Program participants will use Clipper cards to receive the new Means-Based Transit Fare discount.
- 3. *Participating Transit Operators*: Bay Area Rapid Transit, Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (Caltrain), Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District, and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Authority (SFMTA). Other operators may be included after the Pilot Program launches.
- 4. *Single-Ride Discount*: In addition to existing Clipper discounts, Pilot Program participants will receive at least a 20% discount on each trip taken on the participating transit operators. SFMTA will offer a 50% discount for all trips taken by Pilot Program participants.

### **Clipper Coupon**

In August 2018, Clipper staff submitted a change notice to Cubic Transportation Systems, Inc. (Cubic), for the development of the Clipper Coupon in the current Clipper system. In early October, Cubic responded with a proposal to complete the work for the Clipper Coupon by October 2019 for \$1 million.

This contract change order will be funded by State Transit Assistance funds. Cubic is neither a disadvantaged business enterprise nor a small business enterprise.

The Clipper Executive Board approved this item at its December 17, 2018 meeting.

### Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Operations Committee authorize the Deputy Executive Director or designee to negotiate and enter into a Change Order in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 to develop the Clipper Coupon on the Pilot Program.
