Option 8A's methodology will develop new homes in an fire-prone area instead of lowering fire risk by consolidating existing neighborhoods or using infill. It ignores existing urban planning, such as Envision 2040, that calls for densification of transit corridors in Urban Villages. Allowing small-scale infill by eliminating single family zoning is important too. The particular benefit of consolidating neighborhoods on the edges of developed areas is that it reduces fuel load in pockets of undeveloped land and connects suburbs to urbanized areas that can't sustain wildfires.
