- 14 STEPHEN WOLF: THIS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS TO
- 15 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR REHABILITATION ON 11 MILE STRETCH OF 880.
- 16 ALAMEDA COUNTY STARTS AT SANTA CLARA COUNTY LINE. THE 880
- 17 EXPRESS LANES OPENED IN 2020 AND THE PROJECT CONVERTED HOV
- 18 LANES TO AN EXPRESS LANE SO MUCH OF THE CORRIDOR OF THE
- 19 PAVEMENT WAS LEFT IN EXISTING CONDITION AND SIMPLY RESTRIPED.
- 20 THE PAVEMENT REHAB PROGRAM WAS PROGRAMMED IN THE SHOP IN 2018
- 21 THAT'S THE STATE HIGHWAY OPERATION AND PROTECTION PROGRAM
- 22 EARLIER THIS YEAR CALTRANS REQUESTED A FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION
- 23 FROM BAIFA. REHABILITATION IS AN ELIGIBLE EXPENSE FOR TOLL
- 24 REVENUE STATUTE AND BAYREN'S OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE
- 25 AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS INCLUDES OBLIGATION TO FUND EXPRESS



- 1 LANES PORTION OF REHABILITATION PROJECTS. OBLIGATION DOESN'T
- 2 SPEAK TO SCENARIOS WHERE WEARING SURFACE IS NOT IN A LIKE NEW
- 3 CONDITION AT TRANSFER BUT ULTIMATELY CALTRANS, BAIFA AND CTC
- 4 STAFF AGREE WITH \$8.8 MILLION BAIFA CONTRIBUTION WOULD BE
- 5 CONSIDERED BAIFA'S FULL OBLIGATION UNDER THE O&M AGREEMENT AND
- 6 BASED ON THE CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATE. IN ADDITION WE'RE
- 7 REQUESTING A \$900,000 CONTINGENCY 10% OF THE 8.8 MILLION TO BE
- 8 HELD BY BAIFA OFFERING FLEXIBILITY FOR BAYSIDE TO REQUEST
- 9 SCOPE DURING CONSTRUCTION THAT MAY BE BENEFICIAL TO BAIFA THE
- 10 ENTIRE AMOUNT 9.7 MILLION WOULD BE DRAWN FROM BAIFA'S
- 11 UNAUDITED 38 MILLION SURPLUS OPERATING REVENUE AND THE NEXT
- 12 ITEM REQUESTS BUDGET AMENDMENT THAT WOULD ALLOW THIS AND THE
- 13 MEMO IDENTIFIES OTHER REHAB PROJECTS IN THE SHOP TEN YEAR
- 14 PROGRAM THAT MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR BAIFA CONTRIBUTION AND WILL
- 15 BE FACTORED INTO THE LONG RANGE PLAN FOR STAFF PREPARING FOR
- 16 THE FISCAL YEAR 20 YOU 40 BUDGET THE RECOMMENDATION IS THAT
- 17 THE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO
- 18 NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS FOR BAIFA
- 19 TO CONTRIBUTE UP TO \$8.8 MILLION TO THE ALAMEDA I-880 CAPITAL
- 20 PRESENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECT AND THAT BAIFA HOLD AN

- 4 WE HAD AT THE AUDIT COMMITTEE. IS THIS A ONE OFF? OR ARE THERE
- 5 MORE, SORT OF, SYSTEMIC CHANGES THAT WE NEED TO BE KIND OF
- 6 THINKING ABOUT IN TERMS OF, AS WE GROW, AS AN AGENCY,
- 7 ESPECIALLY ON THE, SORT OF, OPERATING BUSINESS SIDE?

- 9 THERESE MCMILLAN: SURE. HAPPY TO. THANK YOU, VICE CHAIR. IN
- 10 MANY WAYS, THIS WAS A COMPLEX CIRCUMSTANCE AT THE OUTSET. THE
- 11 O&M AGREEMENT THAT WAS REFERRED TO BY STEPHEN IS VERY
- 12 COMPLICATED. BUT, AMONG OTHER THINGS, SORT OF, ALLOWED FOR
- 13 VERY DIFFERENT INTERPRETATIONS AT THE OUTSET ON THE NATURE AND
- 14 THE EXTENT OF OBLIGATION IN THIS PARTICULAR ARENA OF
- 15 REHABILITATION -- OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND OWNERSHIP OF
- 16 REHABILITATION AT THE POINT OF OPERATIONAL TRANSFER BETWEEN
- 17 THE STATE AND BAIFA. I THINK IT WAS FURTHER COMPLICATED THAT
- 18 THERE WERE A NUMBER OF CONSULTATIVE PROCEDURES IN THE O&M
- 19 AGREEMENT THAT WERE NOT CLEANLY ADHERED TO BY EITHER CALTRANS
- 20 OR BAIFA. AND THEN THERE WERE MULTIPLE DECISION POINTS ABOUT,
- 21 YOU KNOW, WHEN THIS TOPIC COULD HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED,
- 22 INCLUDING, YOU KNOW, AS STEVEN SAID, THE VERY POINT THAT
- 23 BEFORE WE SIGNED THE O&M AGREEMENT THE STATE HAD CONTRIBUTED
- 24 MONEY. ALL OF THAT IS TO SAY THAT WITH THOSE COMPLEXITIES,
- 25 BAIFA, CALTRANS, AND CTC, INCLUDING THE DIRECT INVOLVEMENT OF



- 1 MYSELF AND DINA EL-TAWANSY DISTRICT FOUR DIRECTOR AND YOUR
- 2 FELLOW COMMISSIONER, DID CONSULT TO ARRIVE AT THE AGREEMENT
- 3 THAT YOU HAVE HERE. AMONG OTHER THINGS ONE OF THE TAKE AWAY
- 4 LESSONS LEARNED IS THE CRITICAL NEED TO MAKE SURE THAT
- 5 AGREEMENTS THAT ARE IN PLACE ARE, AGAIN, REFERRED TO ON A
- 6 CONSISTENT BASIS AND THAT PROCEDURES THAT ARE OUTLINED
- 7 THEREIN, PARTICULARLY AS THEY INVOLVE MULTIPLE PARTIES, YOU
- 8 KNOW, NEED TO BE, YOU KNOW, FOLLOWED. AND THAT PRESENTS
- 9 OPPORTUNITIES HOPEFULLY TO AVOID SOME OF THE COMPLICATING
- 10 FACTORS THAT WE ENCOUNTERED. AND PROBABLY WOULD NOT HAVE, YOU
- 11 KNOW, DEALT WITH ALL OF THEM. BECAUSE AS I SAID BEFORE, THE
- 12 O&M AGREEMENT ITSELF DID NOT FULLY AND CLEARLY ADDRESS SOME OF
- 13 THE ISSUES THAT WERE ON THE TABLE. BUT, I THINK ONE OF THE
- 14 THINGS THAT I WE HAVE LEARNED, I, AND MYSELF, AND DINA EL-
- 15 TAWANSY, HAVE COMMITTED TO DEVELOPING A MORE ON INTENTIONAL,
- 16 YOU KNOW, CONSULTATIVE ENVIRONMENT BETWEEN OUR TWO AGENCIES.
