- 14 GRANDPARENT, GRANDCHILD SPOUSE OR DOMESTIC PARTNER THAT
- 15 REOUIRES PARTICIPATION REMOTELY, A CONTAGIOUS ILLNESS THAT
- 16 PREVENTS THE MEMBER FROM ATTENDING IN-PERSON, AND IN THE CASE
- 17 OF RELATED PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITY DEFINED BY STATUTE OR
- 18 DURING TRAVEL WHILE ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS OF THE LEGISLATIVE
- 19 BODY OR ANOTHER STATE OR LOCAL AGENCY. EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES
- 20 MEANS A PHYSICAL OR FAMILY MISDEMEANOR EMERGENCY THAT PREVENTS
- 21 A MEMBER FROM ATTENDING IN-PERSON KIMBERLY, THE KEY POINTS, AS
- 22 WELL?

- 5 CREATED? I ASSUME BY LEGISLATIVE BODY, THEY MEAN US, AND I'M
- 6 WONDERING IF THAT'S SOMETHING WE HAVE CREATED. AND, I GUESS,
- 7 IN GENERAL, I'M ALSO WONDERING IF WHAT THIS MEANS IS THAT FOR
- 8 PEOPLE WHO CANNOT EVER PHYSICALLY ATTEND A MEETING BECAUSE OF

- 23 LIMITATIONS AS NOTICED SO IT'S NOT THE BEST VEHICLE FOR
- 24 ADDRESSING THINGS LIKE DISABILITY ACCOMMODATIONS WHICH WE WANT
- 25 TO DO. SO WE WILL BE ISSUING GUIDANCE ON ALL OF THAT. AND



- 1 THERE WERE MECHANISMS YOU WERE THE BROWN ACT BEFORE THE
- 2 PANDEMIC THAT ALLOWED ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF PARTICIPATION. SO
- 3 WE WOULD WORK THROUGH THOSE AND MAKE SURE PEOPLE CAN
- 4 PARTICIPATE. SO WE CAN TALK OFFLINE ABOUT DETAILS. BUT, WE'LL
- 5 BE COMING BACK WITH MORE INFORMATION ONCE THE LEADERSHIP HAS
- 6 HAD A CHANCE TO WEIGH IN AND HAVE A CHANCE OF DISCUSSION WITH
- 7 THE GROUP WHEN WE COME BACK IN FEBRUARY.
