- 24 COMMENTS TO THE CLERK BY 5:00 THE DAY BEFORE THE MEETING TO BE
- 25 PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. 375 BEALE STREET,



THE METRO CENTER, IS OUR HEADOUARTERS. WE ARE NOT OFFERING ANY 1 2 ALTERNATE OR SATELLITE LOCATIONS. ALTHOUGH A QUESTION HAS COME 3 UP TO GENERAL COUNSEL THAT I WILL POSE NOW THAT WE CAN ADDRESS AFTER MY REMARKS. WHICH IT'S MY UNDERSTANDING THAT UNDER THE 4 5 BROWN ACT RULES THAT YOU CAN PARTICIPATE REMOTELY IF YOUR NOTICE YOUR LOCATION AND YOU ALLOW PUBLIC ACCESS TO THAT 6 LOCATION. SO, THAT'S A QUESTION TO GENERAL COUNSEL AS TO 7 8 WHETHER THOSE PROVISIONS WOULD APPLY IF YOU PARTICIPATE REMOTELY AND YOU NOTICE YOUR LOCATION. SO, I JUST WANT TO 9 10 THANK YOU ALL FOR MAKING THE EFFORT TO PARTICIPATE IN OUR MEETING SERVING OUR REGION WE LOOK FORWARD TO SEEING YOU IN-11 PERSON. MASKS ARE NOT REQUIRED BUT ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED 12 FOR ALL THOSE WHO WILL BE MEETING IN PERSON. I WOULD LIKE TO 13 ASK MS. - 2 QUESTION, CHAIR ARREGUIN, REMOTE PARTICIPATION IS STILL
- 3 POSSIBLE UNDER THE OLD RULES BACK IN THE DAY WHERE YOU NOTICE
- 4 AND POST YOUR LOCATION AND THAT LOCATION IS OPEN AND
- 5 ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC. IT CREATES SOME PROBLEMS. WE NEED TO
- 6 MAKE SURE WE HAVE ADEQUATE NOTICE THAT SOMEBODY IS DOING THAT
- 7 AND ALSO THAT THAT LOCATION ACTUALLY BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC
- 8 EVEN IF THE MEMBER WHO HAS POSTED TO BE THERE BUT IS UNABLE TO
- 9 ATTEND. SO THERE WILL BE MORE SUBSTANTIVE GUIDANCE COMING OUT
- 10 IN FEBRUARY REGARDING, SORT OF, OUR PROTOCOLS, ONE OF THE
- 11 THINGS THAT WE WANT TO ESTABLISH A BIT INTERNALLY IS THINGS
- 12 LIKE HOW MUCH TIME DO WE NEED TO GIVE THE CLERKS NOTICE SO
- 13 THEY COULD POST IT APPROPRIATELY WE'LL BE ISSUING GRANULAR
- 14 GUIDANCE IN FEBRUARY BUT WE WANTED TO MAKE SURE THAT THE
- 15 RETURN TO IN-PERSON MEETINGS AS A DEFAULT WAS ON EVERYBODY'S
- 16 RADAR FOR MARCH, BECAUSE I THINK WE HAVE ALL GOTTEN MORE USED
- 17 TO REMOTE MEETINGS. NOW THE GOOD NEWS IS, THIS GROUP IS MADE
- 18 UP OF PEOPLE WHO ARE ELECTED OFFICIALS AND ARE VERY FAMILIAR
- 19 WITH THE CONSTRAINTS OF THE BROWN ACT SO WE DON'T HAVE OUITE
- 20 THE HEAVY LIFT HERE AS SOME OF OUR OTHER RELATED ENTITIES BUT
- 21 WE ARE DEFINITELY HERE AS A RESOURCE. THE OTHER THING THAT CAN
- 22 GET A LITTLE FUNKY IS THAT PEOPLE ARE INVOKING 2449 PROVISIONS
- 23 THAT CAN CHANGE THE OUORUM REOUIREMENTS FOR THE IN-PERSON
- 24 MEETING SO THERE HAS TO BE COORDINATION DONE FOR PEOPLE WHO
- 25 MIGHT BE PARTICIPATING REMOTELY TO MAKE SURE WE DON'T RUN A



- 1 FOUL OF OUR NEW POSITION. WE'LL BE SEEING MORE OF THAT IN
- 2 FEBRUARY IN THE MEANTIME I DO ENCOURAGE FOLKS TO REACH OUT TO
- 3 ME IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO. WE ARE PARTICULARLY EAGER TO MAKE
- 4 SURE THAT PEOPLE WHO HAVE ANY KIND OF ACCOMMODATIONS NEEDS

JESSE ARREGUIN: THAT'S RIGHT. 1 2 3 KATHLEEN KANE: AND THOSE ARE SOME VERY NARROW CONSTRAINTS ON WHEN YOU CAN INVOKE THOSE RIGHTS BUT UNDER THE REGULAR OLD 4 5 BROWN ACT PROVISIONS IF YOU CAN NOTICE AND MAKE IT OPEN, THEN THERE IS LESS OF A CONSTRAINT. BUT WE DO NEED TO COORDINATE 6 THOSE TWO THINGS BECAUSE IF WE HAVE MEMBERS INVOKING THE 2449 7 8 AND SOME NOT THEN THERE MAY COMPLICATE THE QUESTION OF HOW MANY PEOPLE NEED TO BE IN-PERSON. - 1 KATHLEEN KANE: WE'RE DEVELOPING THAT KIND OF NETWORK EFFORTS
- 2 THUS FAR OURS AND OTHER SISTER AGENCIES HAVE NOT YIELDED GOOD
- 3 RESULTS BECAUSE THE HOST LOCATIONS DON'T WANT TO TAKE ON THE
- 4 LIABILITY OF HAVING PEOPLE IN AND OUT FOR OUR MEETINGS IS AND
- 5 THERE IS ALSO THE QUESTION ABOUT IT SUPPORT FOR THOSE
- 6 LOCATIONS. WE'RE NOT TREATING THAT AS A DEAD ISSUE. I THINK AS
- 7 EVERYONE HAS TO DO THIS TO RETURN TO IN-PERSON MEETINGS THERE
- 8 MAY BE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING AS WE GO FORWARD THAT REGIONAL
- 9 HUBS ARE REALLY USEFUL AND WE MIGHT HAVE MORE AVAILABILITY TO
- 10 MAKE THOSE ARRANGEMENTS ON A GO FORWARD BASIS. BUT AS OF RIGHT
- 11 NOW MARCH AND EARLY SPRING UNFORTUNATELY WE CAN'T OFFER THAT
- 12 YET. NOW IF SOMEBODY WHO IS WILLING TO VOLUNTEER AND MAKE
