AGENDA ITEM 5A THIS IS THE CUTTING BOULEVARD TRANSIT PRIORITY PROJECT, AC TRANSIT, OF \$3 MILLION. 20 THIS REQUEST IS FOR THE COMMITTEE TO APPROVE AND ENTER INTO A 21 22 FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH AC TRANSIT IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3 MILLION TO PROCURE AND MANAGE CONSULTANTS AND CONTRACTS TO 23 PLAN ENVIRONMENTALLY CLEAR, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCT CUTTING 24 BOULEVARD TRANSIT PRIORITY PROJECTS. MICHELLE GO: GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. MICHELLE GO, 6 PRINCIPLE PLANNER AND DESIGN PROJECT DELIVERY AT MTC. I'M 7 8 JOINED BY SEAN DAIS FLORIDYAN SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNER AT AC TRANSIT WHO WILL BE SERVING AS PROJECT MANAGER. TODAY, 9 WE'LL PROVIDE SUMMARY OF CUTTING BOULEVARD TRANSIT PRIORITY 10 PROJECT WHICH IS PART OF THE RICHMOND SAN RAFAEL FORWARD SUITE 11 OF PROJECTS TO IMPROVE OPTIONS FOR TRAVELING ON THE BRIDGE 12 CORRIDOR. NEXT SLIDE. CONTEXT THERE IS TRANSIT ROUTE THAT 13 TRAVELS RICHMOND SAN RAFAEL GOLDEN GATE TRANSIT ROUTE 580 14 STARTS AT EL CERRITO AND DEL NORTE BART STATION AND TRAVELING 15 16 ALONG CUTTING BOULEVARD BEFORE ENTERING I 580 ON TO RICHMOND SAN RAFAEL BRIDGE AND TERMINATED AS SAN RAFAEL TRANSIT CENTER 17 AC TRANSIT ALSO RUNNING LOCAL SERVICE ON CUTTING BOULEVARD. 18 NEXT SLIDE. THE PROJECT SEEKS TO IMPROVE TRANSIT OPERATIONS 19 AND ACCESS BY IMPLEMENTING TRANSIT SIGNAL PRIORITY ALONG 20 21 CUTTING BOULEVARD AND IMPROVEMENTS AT SHARED GOLDEN GATE 22 TRANSIT AND AC TRANSIT STOPS. LAST YEAR WITH THE REGIONAL MEASURE THREE FUNDING OPPORTUNITY AVAILABLE WE CONVENED STAFF 23 AT SEVERAL STAKEHOLDER AGENCIES DETERMINED THAT AC TRANSIT 24 WOULD BE BEST TO LEAD GIVEN TSP IMPLEMENTATION EXPERIENCE AND 25

ECONOMICS OF SCALE THEY EXPECT TO ACHIEVE BY COOPERATING WITH
 OTHER TRANSIT PRIORITY PROJECT THEY ARE LEADING IN RICHMOND
 ADDITIONALLY AC TRANSIT SUCCESSFULLY APPLIED FOR OTHER FUND
 FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT LOCAL AC TRANSIT ONLY STOPS ALONG CUTTING
 BOULEVARD. NOW I'LL TURN IT OVER TO SEAN TO DISCUSS SCOPE.

SEAN DIESTLORGION: GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. AS MICHELLE 7 8 MENTIONED, THE PROJECT WILL IMPLEMENT TRANSIT SIGNAL PRIORITY TO SIGNALS TO CORRIDORS MODIFICATIONS AND UPGRADES AS NEEDED 9 ALONG THE CORRIDOR CREATING A RELIABLE COORDINATED TRAFFIC 10 SIGNAL SYSTEM IN ADDITION TO TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS THERE 11 WILL BE CHANGES MADE TO BUS STOPS ALONG THE CORRIDOR TO REDUCE 12 DELAY IMPROVE RELIABILITY AND IMPROVE RIDER EXPERIENCE 13 FACILITATING GETTING BUSES IN AND OUT OF BUS STOPS QUICKER AND 14 15 PASSENGERS ON AND OFF BUSES MORE OUICKLY. THE PROJECT IS 16 PROPOSING TO LOCATE SOME BUS STOPS TO THE FAR SIDE OF INTERSECTIONS WHERE POSSIBLE. BUS STOPS WILL BE DESIGNED TO 17 MAINTAIN ADA GUIDELINES, MAINTAIN CLEAR ZONES AT THE BUS 18 DOORS, AND TO BE SUFFICIENT IN LENGTH. NEXT SLIDE. BUS STOPS 19 WITH HIGH PASSENGER BOARDINGS WILL HAVE BUS SHELTERS 20 21 INSTALLED, INCLUDING POWER FOR LIGHTING CURB RAMPS ADJACENT TO 22 THE BUS STOP LOCATIONS WILL BE UPGRADED IF NECESSARY. LASTLY, SIDEWALK REPAIRS AT BUS STOPS THIS INCLUDES REMOVING TRIPPING 23 HAZARDS THAT EXIST TODAY. WITH REGARDS TO SCHEDULE, WE 24 ANTICIPATE COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT BY MID-2026. WE HAVE 25

ALREADY SELECTED THE DESIGNERS FOR THE PROJECT. WE ANTICIPATE
 DESIGN BEGINNING JUNE 2024. AND LASTING THROUGHOUT TO THE END
 OF THE YEAR. CONSTRUCTION IS LIKELY TO BEGIN IN MID 2025 AND
 EXTEND INTO THE EARLY PART OF 2026. I'LL NOW PASS IT BACK TO
 MICHELLE. *

MICHELLE GO: Thanks Sean. today we are seeking approval to into a funding agreement with AC transitfor \$3 million in Regional measure three funds to procure manage and manage consultants and contractors to plan environmentally clear design and construct The Cutting Boulevard Transit priority project subject to the fy2324 Bata budge amendment number two approval we're happy to take any questions.

21 SPEAKER: THE WAY THE TRANSIT PRIORITY WORKS BUSES WILL HAVE A
22 GPS EMITTER ON THE BUS AND AS THEY APPROACH AN INTERSECTION,
23 THEY WILL GET AN EARLY GREEN OR A GREEN EXTENSION.

AND THE SECOND 1 QUESTION IS, THE BUS SHELTERS, LIGHTING, GREAT, WONDERFUL. 2 3 WILL THE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR REALTIME INFORMATION BE INCLUDED IN THIS EVEN IF YOU DON'T HAVE IT AT THIS POINT? 4 5 SPEAKER: BECAUSE THERE IS POWER, THERE WILL BE POWER INTO 6 7 SHELTERS THAT'S A POSSIBILITY. 8 9 GINA PAPAN: I THINK WE SHOULD MAKE IT MORE THAN A POSSIBILITY. (LAUGHTER) WE'RE ALL COMMITTED TO HEADING TOWARDS REALTIME 10 INFORMATION. SO, WHEREVER POSSIBLE, IF YOU COULD ENSURE THAT 11 THAT IS AT LEAST THE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THAT, WILL BE 12 INCLUDED, THAT WOULD BE EXCEPTIONALLY HELPFUL THEN WE'RE NOT 13 GOING BACK AND SPENDING ADDITIONAL MONEY BECAUSE WE DIDN'T 14 15 PLAN AHEAD. 16 SPEAKER: THANK YOU. 17 18 GINA PAPAN: SO, I THINK THAT WOULD BE VERY BENEFICIAL.
