



Adobe Acrobat Reader

Finding Words

You can use the Find command to find a complete word or part of a word in the current PDF document. Acrobat Reader looks for the word by reading every word on every page in the file, including text in form fields.

To find a word using the Find command:

- 1. Click the Find button (**Binoculars**), or choose Edit > Find.
- 2. Enter the text to find in the text box.
- 3. Select search options if necessary:

 Match Whole Word Only finds only occurrences of the complete word you enter in the box. For example, if you search for the word *stick*, the words *tick* and *sticky* will not be highlighted.

Match Case finds only words that contain exactly the same capitalization you enter in the box.

Find Backwards starts the search from the current page and goes backwards through the document.

4. Click Find. Acrobat Reader finds the next occurrence of the word.

To find the next occurrence of the word, Do one of the following:

Choose Edit > Find Again Reopen the find dialog box, and click Find Again. (The word must already be in the Find text box.)

Copying and pasting text and graphics to another application

You can select text or a graphic in a PDF document, copy it to the Clipboard, and paste it into another application such as a word processor. You can also paste text into a PDF document note or into a bookmark. Once the selected text or graphic is on the Clipboard, you can switch to another application and paste it into another document.

Note: If a font copied from a PDF document is not available on the system displaying the copied text, the font cannot be preserved. A default font is substituted.



To select and copy it to the clipboard:

1. Select the text tool T, and do one of the following: To select a line of text, select the first letter of the sentence or phrase and drag to the last letter.

To select multiple columns of text (horizontally), hold down Ctrl+Alt (Windows) or Option (Mac OS) as you drag across the width of the document.

To select a column of text (vertically), Hold down Ctrl+Alt (Windows) or Option+Command (Mac OS) as you drag the length of the document.

To select all the text on the page, choose Edit > Select All. In single page mode, all the text on the current page is selected. In Continuous or Continuous – facing mode, most of the text in the document is selected. When you release the mouse button, the selected text is highlighted. To deselect the text and start over, click anywhere outside the selected text. The Select All command will not select all the text in the document. A workaround for this (Windows) is to use the Edit > Copy command. Choose Edit > Copy to copy the selected text to the clipboard.

2. To view the text, choose Window > Show Clipboard

In Windows 95, the Clipboard Viewer is not installed by default and you cannot use the Show Clipboard command until it is installed. To install the Clipboard Viewer, Choose Start > Settings > Control Panel > Add/Remove Programs, and then click the Windows Setup tab. Double-click Accessories, check Clipboard Viewer, and click OK.

- 6 EXPRESS LANE STARTING THIS FALL AND TWO MONTHS BEFORE TOLLING
- 7 BEGINS IN EARLY 2020 AND 2021 WE WILL FIELD THE CAMPAIGN ABOUT
- 8 TOLLING RULES AND ENCOURAGE DRIVERS TO GET FASTRAK. NEXT SLIDE
- 9 PLEASE. THE ONCE TOLLING BEGINS OUR OPERATIONS CONTRACTOR WILL
- 10 MONITOR TOLLS AND INCIDENTS IN THE EXTENSION JUST LIKE WE DO

- 16 TOLLING WITH INITIAL PERFORMANCE REPORT AND AGAIN ON REGULAR
- 17 BASIS. WE ARE PROPOSING SAME TOLLING RULES ON THE 680
- 18 EXTENSION AS WELL EXISTING 680 FOR CONSISTENCY. AND CUSTOMER
- 19 EDUCATION EFFORT THAT WILL CONTINUE THROUGH THE START OF
- 20 TOLLING ON THE EXTENSION AND THIS PROCESS GIVES US A CHANCE TO
- 21 GET FEEDBACK FROM THE PUBLIC ABOUT TOLLING POLICIES SO WE CAN
- 22 MAKE SURE THEY MAKE SENSE FOR THE REGION OVER TIME. THIS
- 23 CONCLUDES MY PRESENTATION.
