- 18 OPERATIONS PROGRAM FUNDED BY CAP-AND-TRADE REVENUE OPTIONS.
- 19 CHART ON THE SLIDE YOU CAN SEE REVENUE FROM THE THREE PROGRAMS
- 20 FROM THE PAST FISCAL YEAR STA IN GREEN, STATE OF GOOD REPAIR
- 21 IN ORANGE AND OPERATIONS PROGRAM IN BLUE. BASED ON RECENT
- 22 ESTIMATES FOR STATE TRANSIT ASSISTANCE IN THE FISCAL YEAR,
- 23 REVENUE COULD BE LOW BY 40 PERCENT POTENTIAL LOSS OF \$101
- 24 MILLION. -- WE DON'T EXPECT THE SGR REVENUE TO BE IMPACTED BY
- 25 THE CURRENT PANDEMIC CRISIS OR THE LOW CARBON TRANSIT
