

7	PROGRAMMING AND ALLOCATIONS COMMITTEE. I'M CALLING THE MEETING



- 1 JUDIS SANTOS: THANK YOU, CHAIR JOSEFOWITZ. AND GOOD MORNING
- 2 COMMISSIONERS. I AM JUDIS SANTOS. PROGRAMMING MANAGER OF
- 3 EQUITY AND ACCESS AND POLICY AND PROGRAMS SECTION OF MTC.
- 4 THANK YOU FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO PRESENT TO YOU TODAY ON THE
- 5 APPROVAL OF MTC RESOLUTION 4439. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. FOR
- 6 SOMETIME NOW THE COMMISSION HAS ACKNOWLEDGED THAT AS A REGION
- 7 CAUSE SHOULD NOT BE A BARRIER TO RIDING TRANSIT. DUE TO 2017
- 8 REGIONAL BASED STUDY AND POLICY DECISIONS THIS INCLUDED 2018
- 9 REGIONAL BASED FRAMEWORK TO MAKE TRANSIT MORE AFFORDABLE FOR
- 10 RESIDENTS EARNING A LOW INCOME, MOVING TOWARD A CONSISTENT
- 11 STANDARD FOR THE DISCOUNTS AND, THREE DEVELOP IMPLEMENTATION
- 12 OPTIONS THAT ARE FINANCIALLY VIABLE, ADMINISTRATIVELY
- 13 FEASIBLE. ON JULY 15TH, 2020 THE CLIPPER START PILOT LAUNCHED
- 14 WITH FOUR PARTICIPATING OPERATORS, BART, CALTRAIN, GOLDEN GATE
- 15 BRIDGE, HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT, AND THE SAN
- 16 FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY. AND ALSO IN JULY,
- 17 THE COMMISSION DIRECTED 5 MILLION OF THE CORONAVIRUS AID
- 18 RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT FUNDS TO SUBSIDIZE AND HELP
- 19 OFFSET A PORTION OF REVENUE LOSSES TO INCOMING INTERESTED
- 20 CLIPPER START OPERATORS. TODAY'S ITEM IS TO FURTHER AS MTC
- 21 EQUITY PLATFORM WOULD TERM FOCUS AND DELIVER UPON EXPANDING
- 22 THE CLIPPER START PILOT PROGRAM. THE PROPOSED ACTION IS TO
- 23 PROGRAM APPROXIMATELY 5 MILLION MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH CARES
- 24 ACT TO COHORT TO TRANSIT OPERATORS. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. AS
- 25 MENTIONED EARLIER, THE CLIPPER START PROGRAM AIMS TO INCREASE





- 1 MOBILITY FOR PEOPLE IN POVERTY ENABLING CONNECTIONS TO
- 2 SERVICES, EMPLOYMENT, AND EDUCATION. THIS MAP ILLUSTRATES THE
- 3 17 COHORT TWO, INTERESTED PAY THING TRANSIT OPERATORS AND
- 4 THEIR SERVICE AREAS ALONG WITH THEIR COMMUNITIES OF CONCERN.
- 5 PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PARTICIPATION AND DISCOUNT OFFERINGS,
- 6 EITHER 20 OR 50 PERCENT OF PENDING THEIR TRANSIT AGENCY FINAL
- 7 BOARD APPROVALS. FOR THE SOUTH BAY THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY
- 8 TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY OFFERS TWO MEANS-BASED DISCOUNT
- 9 PROGRAMS THAT SERVE THE SAME DEMOGRAPHIC AS CLIPPER START
- 10 RIDERS. MTC AND VTA STAFF ARE CURRENTLY WORKING TOGETHER TO
- 11 ANALYZE IF THE PARTICIPATION OF VTA WOULD PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
- 12 VALUE FOR LOW INCOME VTA RIDERS, AND MAY MODIFY THE CLIPPER
- 13 START PROGRAM OF PROJECTS BASED ON THE ANALYSIS. NEXT SLIDE
- 14 PLEASE. TODAY'S ITEM PROPOSES PROGRAMMING 5 MILLION MADE
- 15 AVAILABLE THROUGH CARES ACT. THE DISTRIBUTION IS DISPLAYED
- 16 GRAPHICALLY ON THE BOARD CHART ON THE LEFT AND LISTED ON THE
- 17 RIGHT AMOUNT LISTED UP TO WHICH AMENDMENT WITH REIMBURSEMENT
- 18 BASED ON ACTUAL CLIPPER START TRIPS TAKEN. OPERATORS WILL BE
- 19 REIMBURSED HALF OF THE 20 PERCENT DISCOUNT. STAFF PROPOSES TO
- 20 PROGRAM FUNDS BASED ON PRE COVID ESTIMATED LOW INCOME
- 21 RIDERSHIP AND FARE REVENUE WITH LOW INCOME RIDERSHIP WEIGHTED
- 22 MORE HEAVILY AT A 60 PERCENT/40 PERCENT DISTRIBUTION. NEXT
- 23 SLIDE. THERE IS AN INTENTIONAL APPLICATION OF MTC'S EQUITY
- 24 PLATFORM IN THIS ITEM AS WELL AS THROUGHOUT THE PILOT. THROUGH
- 25 THIS ITEM THE PILLAR LISTENING LEARNING WAS CONDUCT FROM



- 1 VARIOUS GROUPS FOCUSING ON METRICS AROUND RIDERS EARNING LOW
- 2 INCOMES FOCUS AND DELIVER WITH ACCELERATE THE IMPLEMENTATION
- 3 STARTING WITH THE FOUR OPERATORS LAUNCHED IN JULY EXPANDING
- 4 THE PILOT IN AUGUST AND PROGRAMMING 17 OPERATORS TODAY AND
- 5 LASTLY TRAINING GROW EVALUATING THE PILOT PERIOD TO HELP
- 6 ASSESS THE ATTAINMENT OF THE PROGRAMS GOALS EVALUATION AND
- 7 PUBLIC INFORM PROVIDERS ABOUT THE PUBLIC'S REACH TO INCREASE
- 8 BENEFIT MOBILITY FOR PEOPLE IN POVERTY, EMPLOYMENT, AND
- 9 EDUCATION. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. IN CONCLUSION STAFF
- 10 RECOMMENDATIONS THE COMMITTEE FORWARD TO THE COMMISSION FOR
- 11 APPROVAL MTC RESOLUTION 4439 PROGRAMMING 5 MILLION PROVIDED BY
- 12 CARES ACT FUNDS FOR CLIPPER START PILOT COHORT TWO AGENCIES
- 13 FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021, AND 2021, AND 2022.

- 20 NICK JOSEFOWITZ, CHAIR: TERRIFIC. I WANT TO CONGRATULATE MTC
- 21 AND JUDD AS, YOU ARE, ON THIS PROGRAM. I THINK IT'S TERRIFIC.
- 22 I THINK IN PARTICULAR, WETA, MARIN TRANSIT AND SMART ARE
- 23 OFFERING 60 PERCENT DISCOUNTS FOR LOW INCOME RIDERS IS
- 24 HOPEFULLY GOING TO SET STANDARD AND HOPEFULLY VTA IS FINDING

- 1 ITS WAY TO JOIN THE PROGRAM SO WE CAN HAVE LOW INCOME DISCOUNT
- 2 THROUGHOUT THE REGION. LET'S MOVE ON TO PUBLIC COMMENT.

- 4 CLERK OF THE BOARD: ONE MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC WITH THEIR HAND
- 5 RAISED. ALETA DUPREE.

- 7 SPEAKER: THANK YOU CHAIR JOSEFOWITZ AND MEMBERS. ALETA DUPREE
- 8 FOR THE RECORD. IT'S GOOD TO BE BACK WITH YOU. I COMMEND TO
- 9 YOU MAINTAIN THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS PROGRAM. IT IS HELPFUL TO
- 10 MANY AND HOPEFULLY THE NUMBERS WILL INCREASE. AND THERE ARE
- 11 MANY, SUCH AS MYSELF, WHO RIDE MORE THAN ONE SYSTEM IN A DAY.
- 12 SO, THIS WILL HELP US REACH OUT WITH THIS MEANS-BASED
- 13 DISCOUNTS TO PEOPLE RIDING ADDITIONAL SYSTEMS BESIDES WHAT'S
- 14 OFTEN KNOWN AS THE BIG FOUR. MANY PEOPLE OF LOWER INCOME OFTEN
- 15 LIVE LONG DISTANCES FROM THEIR EMPLOYMENT, OR THEIR EDUCATION,
- 16 AND THE AVERAGE COST OF OWNING AND OPERATING A CAR IN THE
- 17 UNITED STATES IS ABOUT \$700 A MONTH. THAT IS MORE THAN THE
- 18 \$500 A MONTH IT COSTS TO RIDE THE NEW HAVEN LINE FROM NEW
- 19 HAVEN CONNECTICUT TO GRAND CENTRAL TERMINAL IN NEW YORK FOR A
- 20 MONTH. BECAUSE THERE ARE MANY ESSENTIAL WORKERS THAT ARE LOWER
- 21 INCOME, THEY NEED TO HAVE ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE TRANSPORTATION
- 22 THIS WILL ALSO ALLOW PEOPLE TO GET THE CLIPPER CARDS, WHICH
- 23 WILL HELP WITH OUR TITLE SIX MITIGATION EFFORTS. SO, THIS IS A
- 24 PROGRAM ROOTED IN EQUITY, BECAUSE REDUCED FARE MUST NEVER MEAN
- 25 REDUCED SERVICE. I WANT PEOPLE TO GET BACK ON THE BUSES AND



- 1 TRAINS, BECAUSE THIS'S THE FINANCIALLY BEST DEAL OUT THERE.

- 12 WISH IN SOME WAYS IT COULD BE MORE. I UNDERSTAND AND KNOW THAT
- 13 KANSAS CITY WENT TO ZERO FARES. IT'S A MUCH SMALLER SYSTEM
- 14 WITH A LOT LESS REACH. I KNOW LA IS CONSIDERING IT. I DON'T
- 15 THINK IT'S POSSIBLE IN THE BAY AREA, DUE TO THE COST OF
- 16 RENTING THESE TRANSIT SYSTEMS, BUT CERTAINLY WIDE DISCOUNTS
- 17 POWER THOSE PEOPLE THAT NEED THE DISCOUNTS, IS AN EXCELLENT
- 18 PROGRAM, AND I REALLY WANT TO THANK EVERYBODY INVOLVED IN
- 19 THIS, AND ESPECIALLY ALL THE TRANSIT DISTRICTS THAT STOOD UP
- 20 AND AGREED TO THIS. THANK YOU.

- 3 PLAN IS TO SPEND \$200 MILLION A MILE ON BART CONSULTANTS, FOR
- 4 THE BART EXTENSION. PRETTY MUCH 100 PERCENT OF THAT FUNDING IS
- 5 COMING STRAIGHT OUT OF OUR STAFF MEASURES. AT THIS POINT,
- 6 BASICALLY --

- 3 REALLY DOING THE ANALYSIS. SO I REALLY DO APPRECIATE THAT TO
- 4 SEE IF THERE IS SOMETHING THAT MAKES SENSE FOR SANTA CLARA
- 5 COUNTY. AND I WOULD BE PREPARED TO MAKE A MOTION IF THE CHAIR
