

AND SALES CLIPPER PROCESSED APPROXIMATELY 3 MILLION





- 1 TRANSACTIONS AND SETTLED OVER JUST \$6 MILLION IN REVENUE IN
- 2 SEPTEMBER, AND COMPARED TO AUGUST, LAST MONTH, TRANSACTIONS
- 3 WERE UP 13 PERCENT REVENUE UP EIGHT PERCENT OF COURSE IT'S
- 4 DOWN CONSIDERABLY STILL FROM LAST YEAR PRE COVID. AS OF TODAY,
- 5 EIGHT OF THE 22 OPERATORS ARE STILL OFFERING FARE FREE TRAVEL
- 6 DUE TO COVID-19, AND IT'S MY UNDERSTANDING THE CLIPPER AC
- 7 TRANSIT CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER OPENED THIS PAST MONDAY WITH A
- 8 TEMPORARY CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER IN THE LOBBY OF THEIR
- 9 GENERAL OFFICES. IN TERMS OF CUSTOMER EDUCATION, BEGINNING
- 10 THIS MONTH, WE LAUNCHED THE FALL CAMPAIGN FOCUSING ON THE
- 11 MYTHS AND TRUTHS ABOUT CLIPPER. FOR EXAMPLE, MANY TRANSIT
- 12 RIDERS THINK THAT CLIPPER IS ONLY FOR MONTHLY PASS USERS OR
- 13 THAT YOU HAVE TO HAVE A CREDIT CARD TO USE CLIPPER, OR THAT
- 14 TRANSFERS AREN'T AVAILABLE FOR CLIPPER AND CLIPPER CAN'T BE
- 15 USE EVERYWHERE IN THE BAY AREA. THOSE ARE MYTHS AND THE
- 16 CAMPAIGN PROPOSES TO DISPOSE OF MYTHS. ROLLING OUT CLIPPER
- 17 START IN DECEMBER TO SECURE DONATED SPACE AND VEHICLES AND
- 18 WE'LL SUPPLEMENT THAT WITH PURCHASE SPACE AND DIGITAL
- 19 ADVERTISEMENT. THE PLAN PROVIDES DECALS TO AGENCIES THAT WANT
- 20 TO REMIND USERS TO TAG ON AND OFF AND WILL INCORPORATE THIS
- 21 WITH MESSAGING FOR THEIR TERMS. IN TERMS OF IMPLEMENTATION AND
- 22 ENHANCEMENT PROJECT ATTACHMENT A IN YOUR MEMO IS THE MASTER
- 23 WORK SCHEDULE. WANT TO HIGHLIGHT, YOU KNOW THAT AS THE CLIPPER
- 24 START PROGRAM TALKED ABOUT AT THE PREVIOUS MEETING AND HERE,
- 25 THAT BECAUSE WE STARTED THE OUTREACH WE'RE PLANNING WITH THE



- 1 SECOND GROUP OF OPERATORS TO ROLL OUT NO NOVEMBER, AND SECOND
- 2 GROUP OF OPERATORS TO ROLL OUT IN JANUARY 2020. SO WE HAVE THE
- 3 OPERATORS NOW, A NEW GROUP TO BE ROLLED OUT IN NOVEMBER, AND
- 4 THEN A FINAL GROUP IN JANUARY 2021. THAT IS MY REPORT, AND I'M
- 5 HAPPY TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS.
