WE FOCUSED ON THREE YEARS FIRST UNDERLYING 17 FINANCING OF ALL THE BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS REGIONAL MEASURES AND 18 SEISMIC UPGRADES SECOND PIECE OF OUR INVESTIGATIONS FOCUSED ON 19 OPPORTUNITIES TO IMPROVE THE THROUGHPUT OF TRANSPORTATION ON 20 THE BRIDGES, ON TO THE BRIDGES, YOU KNOW, HOW TO PROVIDE FOR 21 TRANSIT EFFICIENCY, FOR ALL THE USES OF THE BRIDGES IN TERMS 22 OF TRANSPORTATION, AND THE THIRD PIECE THAT WE'RE GOING TO BE 23 FOCUSING ON THIS AFTERNOON IS REALLY LOOKING AT THE 24

MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS, SHORT, MID-AND LONG-TERM FOR THE

- 2 TO TANK STAFF FOR PULLING TOGETHER ALL THIS INFORMATION FOR US
- 3 SO THAT WE'RE ABLE TO PUT TOGETHER OUR COMPREHENSIVE
- 4 UNDERSTANDING AND THEN DISCUSSION AND THEN RECOMMENDATION TO
- 5 BATA IN THE COMING -- IN THIS COMING FEW MONTHS. AND I JUST
- 6 WANTED TO TAKE A MOMENT TO THANK COMMISSIONER TAVARES FOR HIS

- 4 CASHLESS TOLLING SYSTEM, AND THEY'RE MOVING VERY QUICKLY
- 5 BECAUSE ON THIS PAST MONDAY THEY BEGAN REMOVING THE TOLL
- 6 BOOTHS AT THE VICTOR EXIT, NUMBER 45, WHICH IS NEAR ROW --
- 7 ROCHESTER THEY HAVE VIDEOS OF THEM PICKING UP THE TOLL BOOTHS
- 8 AND PUTTING THEM UP ON TRUCKS AND STARTING TO TEAR EVERYTHING
- 9 DOWN. IT'S BEEN A BIG LIFT THEY'RE DOING. I'M LOOKING FORWARD
- 10 TO GETTING STARTED WITH THE WORK ON THE THREE NORTHERN BRIDGES
- 11 THAT WE CAN BUILD-OUT, NOT JUST THE CASHLESS TOLLING BUT TO
- 12 REMOVE THE TOLL BOOTHS AND HAVE THE SEAMLESS EXPERIENCE OF
- 13 DRIVING THROUGH AT HIGHWAY SPEED, LETTING THE CAMERAS AND THE
- 14 SCANNERS DO THEIR THING. FASTRAK, OF COURSE, IS THE IDEAL. SO
- 15 WE REALLY WANT TO GET THE WORD OUT ABOUT FASTRAK. IT SHOULD BE
- 16 AS ESSENTIAL AND ROUTINE AS HAVING YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE AND
- 17 YOUR REGISTRATION CAR KEYS, ET CETERA. SO THANK YOU FOR A GOOD
