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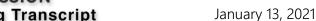

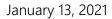

- 13 AMENDMENTS. AND THIS WILL BE PRESENTED BY CFO BRIAN MAYHEW.

- 15 BRIAN MAYHEW: THANK YOU MR. CHAIRMAN, GOOD MORNING AGAIN,
- 16 COMMISSIONERS. THIS IS A VERY MINOR BUT NECESSARY BUDGET
- 17 AMENDMENT. WHAT WE'RE DOING IS WE'RE ADDING \$200,000 TO THE
- 18 OPERATING BUDGET TO FACILITATE EMPLOYEE WORK-FROM-HOME. IT'S
- 19 BROKEN DOWN INTO TWO DISTINCT COMPONENTS, ONE IS WHERE THERE
- 20 WILL BE A \$150 STIPEND TO SUPPORT THE INTERNET CONNECTIONS,
- 21 AND THEN THERE WILL BE A \$450 BANK, SO TO SPEAK, FOR THE
- 22 IMPROVEMENT OF HOME OFFICES AND FACILITIES. THE -- I DON'T
- 23 HAVE THE BREAK DOWN OR HOW ALL OF THIS WILL BE SETUP. I'M JUST
- 24 DOING THE BUDGETING. IT WILL INCREASE THE DEFICIT FROM 1
- 25 MILLION TO 1.2 MILLION AND WE DON'T HAVE ENOUGH DATA YET FOR



- 1 MID-YEAR TO REALLY GIVE YOU AN ANALYSIS OF HOW WE'RE STANDING
- 2 AT MID-YEAR YET, IN ANY EVENT. BUT THAT'S THE REAL BIG BUDGET
- 3 INCREASE WILL COME IN FEBRUARY. AS IT STANDS, THIS ONE IS FOR
- 4 A VERY SPECIFIC PROJECT. I WOULD BE HAPPY TO ANSWER ANY OF
- 5 YOUR OUESTIONS.

- 24 IMPORTANT IN TERMS OF CARRYING OUT THE WORK OF THE
- 25 ORGANIZATION. AND I THINK THE PIVOTING THE PUBLIC
