THE GROUP ALSO REVIEWED DATA 25



1	SHOWING TRAFFIC AND TOLL REVENUE THAT PLATEAUED SINCE THIS
2	SUMMER REMAINING STEADY AT ABOUT 80 PERCENT OF PRE-COVID
3	LEVELS. THIS RESULTS IN A MISMATCH BETWEEN AVAILABLE REVENUE
4	AND CAPITAL FUNDING NEEDS FOR THE TOLL BRIDGE REHABILITATION
5	PRIORITIES IN THE COMING YEARS. AND TO CLARIFY, THE MISMATCH
6	IS BASICALLY WE HAVE INCREASED NEEDS, VITAL NEEDS, AND THE
7	REVENUE IS NOT COMING FORWARD THE WAY WE HAD PLANNED AS A
8	RESULT OF THE LOSS IN REVENUE THIS LAST YEAR. SO THE NEXT
9	WORKING GROUP MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE ON FRIDAY, MARCH 5TH,
10	2021, AT WHICH TIME THE WORKING GROUP WILL FURTHER EXAMINE THE
11	MISMATCH AND THE REVIEW OF THE OPTIONS. AND THIS REVIEW MAY
12	CONTINUE INTO APRIL. AFTER COMPLETING THE REVIEW, THE WORKING
13	GROUP INTENDS TO SUBMIT WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS TO BATA FOR
14	FUTURE CONSIDERATION. SO OUR COMMITTEE WILL BE DELIVERING A
15	WRITTEN REPORT WITH SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATIONS. AND AS WE BRING
16	THOSE RECOMMENDATIONS, WE ARE IN CLOSE CONVERSATIONS WITH
