- 9 BRIDGE, WHICH SPANS THE HUDSON RIVER BETWEEN NEW YORK AND NEW
- 10 JERSEY. I AM SURE MANY OF YOU HAVE PROBABLY BEEN OVER IT. AND
- 11 IT'S A COMPLEX TWO-LEVEL PROJECT. SO THANK YOU FOR BRINGING
- 12 THIS FORWARD. I LOOK FORWARD TO THIS MONEY BEING DEPOSITED SO
- 13 WE CAN SIGN SOME CONTRACTS AND GET TO WORK. IT SHOWS THAT
- 14 BATA IS NOT JUST TALKING THE TALK, BUT WE'RE REALLY WALKING
- 15 THE WALK. THANK YOU.

- 3 BRIDGE AND THE SCHOHARIE CREEK AND THE TRAGEDY OF MINNESOTA
- 4 WHEN BRIDGES FELL AND THE EARTH TAKE TOOK OUT PART OF OUR OLD
- 5 BAY BRIDGE. AND I WISH MORE WOULD COME AND ENGAGE WITH THE
- 6 IMPORTANT WORK. I THINK LIFE WITHOUT THE BRIDGES WOULD BE
- 7 VERY, VERY HARD AND THAT'S HOW IT WAS BEFORE THEY WERE BUILT.
- 8 SO LET'S CONTINUE TO GET OUR MONEY AND TO DO OUR SAFETY
