- 3 THESE TWO OR THREE TIMES A YEAR. THIS ONE IS RELATIVELY
- 4 ROUTINE. IT'S AN ACTUAL REDUCTION OF THE FEDERAL FUNDING. WHAT
- 5 HAPPENS IS THEY GIVE YOU AN ESTIMATE GOING INTO THE YEAR THEY
- 6 START AND THEN THE END OF THE YEAR. THEY REQUIRE SHOWING OF
- 7 THE ACTUAL NUMBERS WE HAVE A REDUCTION OF \$661,000 THERE ARE
- 8 MINOR ADJUSTMENTS TO THE LINE ITEMS BUT NO CHANGES OTHER THAN
- 9 THE REDUCTION IN OVERALL FUNDING. WITH THAT, I WOULD ASK FOR
- 10 APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 4421, OR ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS.

- 25 START OF THE PROCESS FOR THE FEDERAL FUNDING, ACTUALLY FEDERAL





- 1 AND STATE FUNDING NOW, BECAUSE SB1 FUNDS IN THERE. 4458 NOW
- 2 BEGINS THE PROCESS OF AUTHORIZING FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE FY
- 3 '21/'22 YEAR. THE PROGRAM LWT OF THE OVERALL WORK PROGRAM IS
- 4 IN COORDINATION WITH PARTNERS CALTRANS FHWA, FTA AND AT THIS
- 5 POINT WE HAVE INCORPORATED ALL OF THEIR COMMENTS, THEY GET A
- 6 DRAFT ABOUT A MONTH AGO THEY GIVE US THE COMMENTS. WAY TOO
- 7 LATE TO INCORPORATE THEM USUALLY. WE HAVE THEM INCORPORATED.
- 8 THERE MAY BE FURTHER DISCUSSION WITH THEM THAT WILL BE
- 9 INCORPORATED BEFORE FINAL GOES OUT BUT THEORETICALLY IT
- 10 DOESN'T CHANGE THE SIZE OF THE FUNDING. TALKING ABOUT ROUGHLY
- 11 \$20 MILLION IN FUNDING FOR THE YEAR COMING YOU KNOW. FEDERAL
- 12 FUNDS NEW FUNDS THAT ARE GOING INTO THE BUDGET \$13 MILLION
- 13 12.8 IN PPL FUNDS BASIC CORE PLANNING FUNDS FOR MTC'S PLANNING
- 14 OPERATIONS, TRANSPORTATION PLANNING, THEN YOU HAVE STATE
- 15 FUNDING. SB1 FORMULA AND ADOPTION FUNDS OF TWO AND A HALF
- 16 MILLION, WHICH BRINGS US TO A TOTAL NEW FUNDING OF ABOUT \$15
- 17 MILLION. NOW YOU ALSO HAVE PROGRAM CARRYOVER FUNDS, YOU JUST
- 18 FINISHED THE OTHER RESOLUTION. YOU JUST APPROVED THOSE TO THE
- 19 END OF THE YEAR NOW YOU'RE APPROVING CARRYING TO NEXT YEAR
- 20 THOSE ARE ABOUT \$4.7 MILLION, AND THAT MAKES UP THE TOTAL OF
- 21 THE \$20 MILLION -- \$20.1 MILLION THAT'S INVOLVED IN THE
- 22 RESOLUTION, AND IN THE OWP. BASICALLY RESO 448, WE HAVE SEEN
- 23 THIS MANY TIMES AND YOU WILL SEE IT AGAIN AFTER WE INCORPORATE
- 24 THIS INTO THE MTC BUDGET, AND THEN WE TIE THIS OFF TO WHAT'S
- 25 IN THE MTC BUDGET. 448 APPROVES THE 20.1 MILLION IN FEDERAL



- 1 AND STATE FUNDING ALSO CARRYOVER ALSO CERTIFIES WHAT YOU ARE
- 2 DOING UP TO DATE WITH THE PLANNING PROCESSES AND YOU WILL SEE
- 3 A LIST ATTACHED TO THE RESOLUTION IT AUTHORIZES EXECUTIVE
- 4 DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR NEW GRANTS AND IT AUTHORIZES US TO MAKE
- 5 ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES, NORMAL ROUTINE THINGS PROVIDE THE
- 6 BUDGET IN ITSELF THE DOLLARS DON'T GO UP. WITH THAT I WOULD BE
- 7 HAPPY TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS AND ASK THAT YOU APPROVE
- 8 RESOLUTION 4448.
