- 23 EVEN THINK ASSOCIATION THINK WE DO. IT'S CHALLENGING TIME AND
- 24 IMPORTANT TO DO IT RIGHT. WE NEED TO STAY THE COURSE. I THINK
- 25 TRAFFIC IS GOING TO COME BACK AND MONEY IS GOING TO COME BACK



AND I ASK YOU TO NOT BE AFRAID OF THE FUTURE BECAUSE MONEY 1 WILL TAKE CARE OF ITSELF. IT'S BETTER TO DO THINGS SOONER THAN 2 3 LATER BECAUSE WHEN WE WAIT, THE COST OF PROJECTS GO UP.
