IS THERE A WAY TO CRANK THAT UP A BIT? 4 5 RAYMOND WOO: IS THIS BETTER? 6 7 CAROL DUTRA-VERNACHI, CHAIR: YES. 8 RAYMOND WOO: THIS IS RAYMOND WMTC STAFF I'LL BE PRESENTING THE 9 SAFE RESOLUTIONS FISCAL YEAR 2021 OPERATES CAPITAL BUDGETS. I 10 THINK I HAVE PRESENTATIONS TODAY. THANK YOU. YOU CAN GO TO THE 11 NEXT SLIDE, PLEASE? SO, MTC, SAFE, HAS TWO OPERATES -- THE 12 OPERATIONS HAVE TWO PROGRAMS. THE FIRST ONE IS THE FREEWAY 13 ASSIST PROGRAMS. THEY PROVIDE [INDISCERNIBLE] SERVICE ALONG 14 THE ROAD SAY, AND THE SECOND IS THE FREEWAY SERVICE PATROL 15 16 PROVIDING VEHICLE TOWING SERVICE ON THE FREEWAY. IN THE PROPOSED FY '22 BUDGET, SLIGHT OPERATES DEFICIT WHICH WILL BE 17 COVERED FROM THE RESERVE OF APPROXIMATELY \$12.5 MILLION AT THE 18 END OF FISCAL YEAR '19/'20. THE OPERATES REVENUES IN THE 19 POSTED BUDGET IS AT \$21.4 MILLION UP FROM \$376,000 OR UP 8%. 20 THE PROPOSED EXPENSE ARE \$21.8 MILLION UP 1.8% FROM FY 21 22 '21/'22, ALSO. THE FUNDS SHIFTED FROM SUPPORT FUNDS, SLIGHTLY HIGHER EXPENSE CREATED OPERATES DEFICITS SIMILAR TO FISCAL 23 YEAR 2021. NEXT SLIDE. TOTAL OPERATES REVENUE \$21.4 MILLION. 24

- 1 REGISTRATIONS, AS WELL AS STATE LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND THE SB1
- 2 GRANT. WE'RE NOT SEEING ANY SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO THESE
- 3 FUNDING SOURCES IN THE FISCAL YEAR '21/'22. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE.
- 4 OPERATES EXPENSE UP 1.8%, OR \$381,000. MAJORITY OF THE
- 5 INCREASE IS DUE TO A STAFF REASSIGNMENTS TO THE SAFE PROGRAMS
- 6 FROM OTHER PROGRAMS. AND THERE IS -- AND MOVING TO NEXT SLIDE,
- 7 SO, ON THE CAPITAL SIDE, STAFF IS -- EXCUSE ME -- ON THE
- 8 CAPITAL SIDE, STAFF IS TRANSFERRING \$1.5 MILLION TO THE
- 9 CAPITAL SIDE IN THE FY '21/'22 FOR TWO NEW PROJECTS FIRST ONE
- 10 IS FOR THE INCIDENT MANAGEMENTS PROGRAM FOR \$1 MILLION, AND
- 11 THE CONNECTED BAY AREA PROGRAMS FOR HALF A MILLION DOLLARS.
- 12 WITH THE TRANSFER, THE CAPITAL PROGRAMS WILL HAVE A SLIGHTLY,
- 13 LIKE, A NINE -- SLIGHTLY HIGHER, A \$9 MILLION BUDGETS THROUGH
- 14 FY '22. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. FOR MTC SAFE RESOLUTION NUMBER 68,
- 15 IT WILL AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATORS TO MTC SAFE, FISCAL YEAR
- 16 '21/'22 BUDGET, IT ALLOWS STAFF TO MAKE BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS
- 17 WITHIN LINE ITEMS BUT NO OVERALL INCREASE TO THE '21/'22
- 18 BUDGET WITHOUT SAFE APPROVAL AND DEDICATED CONTRACT
- 19 ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL OF OPERATIONS COMMITTEE HAS AUTHORIZED
- 20 CARRYOVER BUDGETING ALL GRANT CONTRACT AND FUNDS COMPLETED
- 21 DURING FISCAL YEAR 2021 AND ALSO DEDICATED RESERVE FOR BUDGET
- 22 YEAR END EXPENSE AND OPERATES RESERVE. FY '21 AND '22, THE
- 23 RESERVE IS AS FOLLOWS HALF A MILLION DOLLARS FOR YEAR END IN
