ONE OF THE ISSUES WITH THE FERRY SYSTEM IS 20 21 THAT IT'S STILL RUNNING ON DIESEL, WATERCRAFT, AND THERE 22 SHOULD BE A LITTLE PUSH TO CHANGE TO ALL ELECTRIC AND SOLAR POWERED WATERCRAFT TO REDUCE EMISSIONS, AND FOR 23 SUSTAINABILITY, AS WELL, TO REDUCE COST, DUE TO THE HIGH COST 24 OF DIESEL FUEL, AND MORE AUTOMATION SO WE CAN REDUCE STAFFING 25

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ON BORED THE BOARDS. DRIVERLESS NAVIGATION ON THE BOARDS ALL OF 1 2 THOSE COSTS WOULD ALLOW BETTER HEADWAYS AND A ROBUST SYSTEM. A LOT OF WATER, WE SHOULD USE THAT TO COMPLIMENT RAILS AND BUS 3 SYSTEMS. THANK YOU. 4 5 CLERK, KIMBERLY WARD: THANK YOU. I SEE NO ADDITIONAL RAISED 6 7 HANDS, MR. CHAIR. YOU ARE MUTED, MR. CHAIR: I WANT TO REITERATE MY CONCERNS 2 3 THAT WERE BROUGHT UP IN THE COMMITTEE ABOUT THE CALL CENTER, AND STAFF HAVE BEEN UNDER UNBELIEVABLE AMOUNTS OF PRESSURE 4 5 COMING FROM THE INCREASING NUMBER OF CALLS TO CUSTOMER SERVICE REGARDING THE TOLLING POLICIES. WHEN THE AVERAGE CALLER HAS TO 6 WAIT OVER 20 MINUTES TO GET THROUGH THERE ARE MANY CALLERS 7 8 DROPPING OFF, WE SHOULD NOT BE IMPOSING SIGNIFICANT PENALTIES, IF AT ALL, FOR LATE PAYMENT OF TOLLS, AND I THINK THAT'S 9 SOMETHING THAT I'M GOING TO BE FOLLOWING UP WITH STAFF ON. AND 10 I HAVE BEEN FOLLOWING UP WITH STAFF ON -- AND I JUST KIND OF 11 WANTED TO RAISE THAT IN THIS FORUM AGAIN. 12

CINDY CHAVEZ: THANK YOU. I ACTUALLY WANTED TO ECHO NICK'S 17 POINT, AND I ALSO JUST WANTED TO SAY TWO THINGS. THAT, ONE, AS 18 IT RELATES TO HOW WE'RE ADDRESSING EOUITY, I THINK WE'RE GOING 19 IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION, BUT I'M STILL A LITTLE CONCERNED AND I 20 21 THINK IT TIES INTO THE NEXT POINT ABOUT ACCESS TO BEING ABLE TO RESOLVE ISSUES AND WHETHER OR NOT WE'RE LEARNING QUICKLY 22 ENOUGH FROM THAT IN TERMS OF HOW TO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO FOLKS 23 WHO NEED TO CROSS BRIDGES. THE SECOND THING I WANTED TO SAY IS 24 JUST TO THE STAFF, YOU KNOW, THE STAFF REPORTS ARE EXCELLENT, 25

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AND THE BRIEFING THAT I GOT FROM YOUR TEAM WAS REALLY, REALLY 1 HELPFUL. LIKE, YOU KNOW, KIND OF A MASTER CLASS, AND HOW TO 2 3 EDUCATE PEOPLE ABOUT THE NEW BORED THEY'RE SITTING ON. SO THERESE, I JUST WANT TO SAY THANK YOU IT YOUR TEAM. WELL DONE. 4 5 FRANKLY PART OF THE REASON I DIDN'T HAVE A LOT OF OUESTIONS IS BECAUSE THE STAFF REPORT WAS SO WELL DONE. THANK YOU. 6 7 8 ALFREDO PEDROZA, CHAIR: THANK YOU COMMISSIONER CHAVEZ. ALL RIGHT. SO I BELIEVE WE DO HAVE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC THAT WISH 9 TO PROVIDE PUBLIC COMMENT 10

12 CLERK, KIMBERLY WARD: WE DO, MR. CHAIR. FIRST IS ALETA DUPREE.
13 PLEASE UNMUTE YOURSELF. YOU HAVE TWO MINUTES.

14

15 SPEAKER: THANK YOU, CHAIR ALFREDO AND MEMBERS. ALETA DUPREE 16 FOR THE RECORD, SHE AND HER. LOVE A GREAT MEETING. LOOKING FORWARD TO THIS BUDGET BEING IMPLEMENTED. WE HAVE BEEN DOING 17 LOTS OF GOOD THINGS, INCLUDING WORKING ON OUR CASHLESS TOLLING 18 SYSTEM. I THINK IT'S IMPORTANT THAT WE HAVE A DASHBOARD THAT 19 DETAILS THE PROGRESS OF THE WORK ON THESE SEVEN STATE OWNED 20 BRIDGES FROM CONTRACT AWARD TO INITIAL DESIGN ALL THE WAY 21 THROUGH CONSTRUCTION AND TESTING AND COMMISSIONING. THIS WORK 22 IS HAPPENING IN VARYING DEGREES AROUND THE COUNTRY. NEW YORK, 23 LAST I READ, HAS TAKEN DOWN 38 TOLL PLAZAS ON THE THRUWAY. AND 24 THE NEW YORK BRIDGE AUTHORITY IS GOING TO START THE CASHLESS 25

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TOLLING SYSTEM INCREMENTALLY ON FIVE BRIDGES THAT CROSS THE 1 HUDSON RIVER NORTH OF NEW YORK CITY, AND THERE IS ALSO VARIOUS 2 3 CONSTRUCTION AND IMPLEMENTATION GOING ON IN FLORIDA AND KANSAS, AND OKLAHOMA. I THINK WHAT'S DISTINCT IS THAT WE HOLD 4 5 MORE MEETINGS AND WE TALK ABOUT THIS MORE. I AM MUCH MORE INFORMED ABOUT BATA THAN I AM ABOUT OTHER AGENCIES. SO I HOPE 6 TO BE ON THE BRIDGES SOON. INTEROPERABILITY IS ESSENTIAL. WE 7 8 DON'T HEAR MUCH ABOUT THAT, BUT I THINK WE NEED TO SEE WHERE WE'RE AT WITH INTEROPERABILITY SO THAT PEOPLE WITH EASY PASS 9 AND THOSE TYPE OF PASSES CAN USE OUR SYSTEM FREELY. ESPECIALLY 10 WITH THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY, THERE ARE A LOT OF TRUCKS THAT 11 CROSS THE COUNTRY. I LOOK FORWARD TO THE MEETINGS AND GETTING 12 THIS WORK DONE. THANK YOU. 13

15 CLERK, KIMBERLY WARD: THANK YOU. NEXT SPEAKER RENI TAN. YOU
16 HAVE TWO MINUTES.

17

18 SPEAKER: I WANT TO COMMENT REGARDING THE ISSUE WITH THE BRIDGE TOLLS, ONE OF THE PROBLEMS IS THAT WE BASICALLY STILL HAVE THE 19 TOLL BOOTHS THERE, AND IT CAUSES CONGESTION. I WAS WATCHING 20 THE NEW YESTERDAY AND LOOKING AT THE BACKUP ON THE BAY BRIDGE 21 THROUGH THE TOLL GATES. AS WELL AS, IT LOOKS LIKE METERING 22 LIGHTS WEREN'T WORKING OUITE L SO PRIORITY SHOULD BE PULLING 23 THE TOLL BOOTHS OUT AND REPLACING THEM WITH A GANTRY SYSTEM, 24 AS WELL AS GETTING RID OF THE TOLL PLAZAS SO WE'RE NOT HAVING 25

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1 A NEXT DOWN GOING FROM MULTI-LANES DOWN TO THE LANES ON THE 2 BAY BRIDGE. AND IDENTICAL ON EACH SIDE OF THE TOLL PLAZA TO 3 PREVENT THE BOTTLENECKING AS THE LANES CHANGES. SO, HOPEFULLY 4 THE INFRASTRUCTURE MONEY CAN BE PRIORITIZED TO DEMOLITION OF 5 ALL THOSE TOLL BOOTHS, YOU KNOW, ACROSS ALL THE BRIDGES. THANK 6 YOU.

8 CLERK, KIMBERLY WARD: THANK YOU. NEXT SPEAKER IS VEDA FLOREZ.
9 PLEASE UNMUTE YOURSELF. YOU HAVE TWO MINUTES, MS. FLOREZ.
10

VEDA FLOREZ: GOOD MORNING. THIS IS VEDA FLOREZ FROM MARIN 11 COUNTY. I WANT TO EXPRESS MY APPRECIATION FOR ALL THE WORK 12 THAT HAS BEEN DONE ON ADJUSTING TOLLS, OR ELIMINATING THE 13 FINES. BUT THERE STILL NEEDS TO BE A LOT OF WORK DONE. AND IN 14 15 THE LAST COUPLE OF MEETINGS, I EXPRESSED MY DISSATISFACTION 16 WITH THE TOLLS. A FRIEND OF MINE INCURRED UP TO \$4,000 ATTACHED TO HER TAXES, THROUGH THE FRANCHISE TAX BOARD. THAT 17 BEING SAID, SHE WAS A SPANISH SPEAKER, SHE DIDN'T SPEAK 18 ENGLISH, AND IT WAS VERY DIFFICULT FOR ME, BECAUSE --19 NAVIGATING THE SYSTEM, AS AN ENGLISH SPEAKER AND BEING PART OF 20 THE PUBLIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE, I THOUGHT THAT PERHAPS I COULD 21 NAVIGATE THE SYSTEM FOR HER. BUT THERE ARE STILL AREAS THAT 22 NEED TO BE LOOKED AT, SUCH AS INFORMATION. IF YOU DO NOT PAY 23 YOUR FINE, YOU KNOW, THE MTC AND [INDISCERNIBLE] MAY ATTACH 24 YOUR FEDERAL INCOME TAXES. YOU MAY LOSE YOUR HOUSE. YOU MAY 25

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HAVE ALL SORTS OF THINGS HAPPEN TO YOU THAT PEOPLE DON'T 1 UNDERSTAND, AND I KNOW THAT YOU ARE NOT ATTACHING HOME 2 3 OWNERSHIP OR TAKING AWAY CAR REGISTRATION OR DRIVER'S LICENSE. BUT THERE NEEDS TO BE SOME INFORMATION THAT PROVIDES THE 4 5 CUSTOMER OF WHAT MEANS THAT YOU WILL GO TO RETRIEVE YOUR SO, I THINK THAT'S VERY IMPORTANT TO HAVE THE --MONEY. 6 EXCUSE ME -- TO HAVE THE USER PAY THEIR FINES. HOW DO PEOPLE 7 8 KNOW IF I WAIT TOO LONG, I'M GOING TO INCREASE -- I MAY INCREASE THE TOLLS. BUT I DON'T UNDERSTAND. HOW DON'T SPEAK 9 10 ENGLISH. WHO CAN I TALK TO THAT SPEAKS SPANISH, IS THERE A SHORT TUTORIAL OR VIDEO THAT I CAN WATCH. HOW CAN I FIND A 11 MEANS TO END, TO ALLEVIATE THE ISSUE?
