- 17 THIS IS ABOUT THE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER FOR FASTRAK. AND DO WE
- 18 HAVE A PRESENTATION? YES. MS. BETH ZELINSKI.

- 20 BETH ZELINSKI: GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. I'M BETH ZELINSKI
- 21 WITH BATA STAFF. AND THIS ITEM IS TO APPROVE ADDITIONAL COSTS
- 22 FOR ALL ELECTRONIC TOLL INVOICES AND TO APPROVE A TWO YEAR
- 23 CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH CONDUENT STATE AND LOCAL SOLUTIONS TO
- 24 OPERATE THE FASTRAK CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER IN AN AMOUNT NOT
- 25 TO EXCEED \$112,854,000. THE CFC CONTRACT BEGAN IN NOVEMBER





- 1 2014 WITH A FIVE YEAR INITIAL OPERATING TERM TO OCTOBER 2019,
- 2 AND UP TO TEN YEARS OF OPTIONAL EXTENSIONS AT BATA'S
- 3 DISCRETION. THE COMMITTEE DID PREVIOUSLY APPROVE A TWO AND A
- 4 HALF YEAR EXTENSION TO MARCH 2022 WHICH IS NEXT YEAR. WE ARE
- 5 CONSIDERING ANOTHER TWO YEAR EXTENSION TO MARCH 2024. STAFF
- 6 HAS STARTED TO DEVELOP A PROCUREMENT PLAN TO REBUILD THE
- 7 CONTRACT AND EFFORTS TO PROCURE A NEW VENDOR AND DEVELOP AND
- 8 TEST A NEW SYSTEM DOES TAKE SIGNIFICANT EFFORT AND SEVERAL
- 9 YEARS TO COMPLETE. WE DID START SOME INITIAL EFFORTS HOWEVER
- 10 THOSE WERE DISRUPTED BY THE PANDEMIC IN ADDITION WE ARE SEEING
- 11 CHANGES UNDER WAY FOR THE MONITORING THAT WE WANT TO
- 12 INCORPORATE INTO OUR STRATEGIES FOR A NEW VENDOR AND OPERATION
- 13 CONTRACT. THIS EXTENSION WILL BE NEEDED TO ALLOW ADDITIONAL
- 14 TIME TO COMPLETE PROJECT AND THE SELECTED VENDOR'S SYSTEM
- 15 DEVELOPMENT PROCESS. IN ADDITION TO THE CONTRACT EXTENSION
- 16 THERE IS AN ADDITIONAL \$10 MILLION IN ADDITIONAL FUNDS THAT
- 17 ARE NEEDED FOR HIGHER INVOICE COST FOR THE CURRENT YEAR, THE
- 18 ORIGINAL COST ESTIMATED WAS BASED ON A LOWER PERCENTAGE OF
- 19 INVOICE TRANSACTIONS AND WE HAVE ALSO SEEN TRAFFIC VOLUMES
- 20 RETURN FASTER THAN NORMAL THAN WE HAD ANTICIPATED LEADING TO A
- 21 HIGHER TRANSACTION COST. THE CURRENCY OPERATION DOES CONTINUE
- 22 TO STRUGGLE WITH THE DEMAND DUE TO INCREASED VOLUMES FROM THE
- 23 BAT THAT BRIDGE TRANSITION THAT HAPPENED IN JANUARY OF 2021
- 24 AND THE WINDING DOWN OF CASHLESS TOLL NOTICES FROM 2020. THE
- 25 PANDEMIC DOES CONTINUE TO CREATE HIRING CHALLENGES TO HAVE





- 1 SUFFICIENT STAFF TO HANDSEL THE CUSTOMER CALL VOLUME. CONDUENT
- 2 IS IN THE PROCESS OF STARTING UP A NEW CALL CENTER IN
- 3 BAKERSFIELD AND THIS WILL ALLOW THE SPACE THAT THEY NEED SEAT
- 4 MORE CALL AGENTS. THE BAKERSFIELD SITE WAS AN EXISTING
- 5 CONDUENT FACILITY, THEY ARE RAPIDLY DEPLOYING THIS AND HAD
- 6 THEIR FIRST TRAINING CLASS ON JUNE 28TH AND WILL START TAKING
- 7 CALLS FROM THAT FACILITY NEXT MONDAY. THE INITIAL CLASS WAS
- 8 LARGE, IT HAD 90 AGENTS THEY ARE TRYING TO STAFF UP AS QUICKLY
- 9 AS POSSIBLE HOWEVER WE DO EXPECT SEEING QUITE A BIT OF
- 10 ATTRITION FROM THAT INITIAL CLASS IN LINE WITH THE HIRING
- 11 TRENDS OVER THE PAST YEAR AND ANOTHER CLASS WILL FOLLOW
- 12 DIRECTLY BEHIND THAT AND CON CONSTITUTE WILL CONTINUE TO STAFF
- 13 UP UNTIL THEY HAVE LEVELLED NEEDED TO SUPPORT AET. ASSUMING
- 14 THE FACILITY START UP GOES SMOOTHLY AND FORECASTING THEY WILL
- 15 BE NEAR PERFORMANCE LEVELS BY THE END OF AUGUST, WE SHOULD SEE
- 16 A SIGNIFICANT REDUCTION IN CALL WAIT TIME. PUTTING FORTH THIS
- 17 EFFORT AND DELIVERING MAJOR STAFFING INCREASE IS A SIGNIFICANT
- 18 CHALLENGE BUT BATA IS SUPPORTING THAT EFFORT AND WE ARE
- 19 MONITORING CONDUENT'S WORK, AND WE ARE HAVING STAFF ON HAND,
- 20 IN BAKERSFIELD NEXT WEEK AS THEY START UP THE CALL ANSWERING.
- 21 AND SO, AT YOUR SEPTEMBER MEETING, WE WILL PROVIDE MORE
- 22 INFORMATION AND MORE UPDATES ON THE STATUS OF THE CSC
- 23 OPERATIONS. SO, WITH THAT, STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT THE
- 24 COMMITTEE AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND
- 25 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER WITH CONDUENT FOR

- 2 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED 12,854,000, AND I WOULD BE HAPPY TO

- 13 GOING TO BE ANY SURPRISE TO ANYBODY, BUT I APPRECIATE THE NOTE
- 14 IN THE MEMO THAT INDICATES THAT YOU WILL BE COMING BACK TO US
- 15 IN SEPTEMBER WITH SOME IDEAS AROUND FINES AND FEES AROUND
- 16 EQUITABLE IN PARTICULAR FOCUS ON LOW-INCOME PEOPLE RACKING UP
- 17 \$70 FINES EVERY TIME YOU GO ACROSS THE BRIDGE CAN BE REALLY
- 18 EXPENSIVE AND PEOPLE WHO GET INTO DEBT IT WOULD BE HARD TO
- 19 CLIMB OUT OF IT I APPRECIATE THAT WE'RE GOING TO SEE CONCRETE
- 20 ACTION OR CONCRETE PROPOSALS IN SEPTEMBER, AND I'M LOOKING
- 21 FORWARD TO ENGAGING ON THAT. AND THEN, YOU KNOW, I HOPE THAT
- 22 WHEN WE DO THIS CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH CONDUENT THAT WE CAN
- 23 TAKE THAT INTO ACCOUNT IN CHANGES OF HOW FINES AND FEES ARE
- 24 HANDSELLED BASED ON THE MEMO AND IT DOESN'T BECOME A MASSIVE
- 25 CHANGE ORDER SITUATION WHICH I KNOW SOME OF THESE GOVERNMENT

- 16 IS WORKING TO HIRE MORE BILINGUAL STAFF AND THEY ARE GETTING
- 17 SIGNIFICANT STAFF IN BAKERSFIELD THAT WILL BE ABLE TO HANDSEL
- 18 THOSE CALLS DIRECTLY.

- 20 GINA PAPAN: OKAY. BETH, IF WE COULD GET POSSIBLY A NUMBER OF
- 21 BILINGUAL CALLS THAT COME IN SO WE KNOW WHAT WE'RE
- 22 APPROACHING, WHETHER IT'S MANDARIN OR HISPANIC, WE HAVE SO
- 23 MANY LANGUAGES IN CALIFORNIA THAT MIGHT BE HELPFUL TO US AS WE
