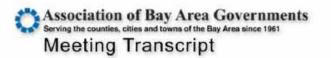

- 14 BY THE 412 HOUSEHOLDS PROJECTED IN THAT AREA RESULTED IN
- 15 REDUCTION IN THE COUNTY'S TOTAL RHNA OF 35 UNITS. AS ALLOWED
- 16 BY HOUSING ELEMENT LAW THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE DETERMINED
- 17 THAT THESE 35 UNITS SHOULD BE TRANSFERRED TO THE CITY OF
- 18 PITTSBURGH IN THE INCOME CATEGORIES SHOWN HERE. NEXT SLIDE
- 19 PLEASE. IN CONCLUSION, THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE IS
