FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2021
 AND MR. WOO WILL GIVE THIS REPORT. WELCOME.

RAYMOND WOO: GOOD EVENING. MY NAME IS RAYMOND WOO, BUDGET 4 5 MANAGER FOR ABAG. I'LL BE PRESENTING THE UNAUDITED ABAG FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR PERIOD ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2021, WHICH 6 INCLUDE FINANCIAL INFORMATION ABAG ADMIN FUND, BAYREN ENERGY 7 8 SAN FRANCISCO ESTUARY PARTNERSHIP AND SAN FRANCISCO BAY TRAIL. AS OCTOBER 31, 2021, A COMBINED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS REPORT 9 10 SURPLUS OF \$1.2 MILLION WITH THE FOLLOWING HIGHLIGHTS FOR EACH ENTITY. FOR ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDS REPORTING \$1.62 MILLION 11 SURPLUS FOR THIS PERIOD MAJOR PROGRAMS TWO WENT \$4 MILLION 12 MEMBERSHIP DUES FROM THE COUNTIES AND CITIES. AS OF THE END OF 13 OCTOBER WE HAVE COLLECTED CLOSE TO 90% OF THE BUDGETED 14 15 MEMBERSHIP DUE. AS NOTED IN PREVIOUS MEMOS THE MEMBERSHIP 16 REVENUES ARE FOCUSED FULLY AT THE BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR WHEN THE INVOICE IS SENT TO THE MEMBERS. EVEN THOUGH CASH 17 COLLECTED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR AND ON THE OTHER HAND THE 18 PENSIONS EXPENSE IS AMORTIZED OVER THE COST OF THE YEAR EVEN 19 THOUGH THE FULL AMOUNT OF \$1.6 MILLION WAS PAID IN THE 20 21 BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR. THIS MAKES THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS SHOW A SIGNIFICANT YEAR TO DATE SURPLUS OF THE \$1.2 22 MILLION. AND THEN, YEAR TO DATE EXPENDITURES IS SLIGHTLY LOWER 23 THAN THE BUDGETS DUE TO SOME OF THE BUDGET'S TRANSFER HAS NOT 24 25 BEEN MADE YET. ALSO, IN DECEMBER OF 2021, THE METROPOLITAN

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TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AUTHORIZED STAFF TO RETURN SURCHARGE 1 COLLECTED IN FISCAL YEAR 2021 AND ALSO SERVICES OPERATIONS 2 3 ASSESSMENT FEE PAYMENTS MADE IN 2020 AND FISCAL YEAR 21 AND '22 AND TOTAL REFUND ESTIMATED \$925,000 IN ADDITION ABAG IS 4 5 REQUIRED TO MAKE THE \$530,000 REQUIRED FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR. MOVING TO BAYREN PROGRAMS. THE BAYREN PROGRAMS REPORT A 6 7 DEFICIT OF \$3,000 DUE TO -- DUE -- YES? SORRY? 8 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: I DON'T THINK ANY OF US HAVE ASKED ANY 9 10 QUESTIONS YET. 11 RAYMOND WOO: ALL RIGHT. SO --12 13 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: YOU STOPPED AT BAYREN AND -- THE ISSUE 14 15 IS THEY GET -- THEY HAVE EXPENDITURES BEFORE WE GET ALL THE 16 GRANT DOLLARS. 17 **RAYMOND WOO:** YES THERE IS \$3,000 OF DEFICIT DUE TO A BUILDING 18 DELAY. EXPENDITURES BELOW BUDGET AS OF THE REPORTING PERIOD, 19 BUT IS EXPECTING TO CATCH UP LATER IN THE YEAR, AS CONSULTANTS 20 21 INCENTIVE COST TYPICALLY COMES IN AT THE MIDDLE, MID-YEAR POINT OF THE FISCAL YEAR. MOVING TO SFEP PROGRAMS THAT PROGRAM 22 IS REPORTING \$17,000 OF DEFICIT, AGAIN, DUE TO BILLING, TIMING 23 OF THE BILLING FOR THE GRANT PROGRAMS. SAN FRANCISCO BAY TRAIL 24 NON-PROFIT ENTITIES CURRENT AS OF END OF OCTOBER THERE IS NO 25

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EXPENDITURES REPORT FOR THAT PROGRAM FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL 1 2 WITH THAT, I CONCLUDE MY REPORT OF THE ABAG YEAR YET. 3 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AS OF THE END OF THE PERIOD OCTOBER 31ST, 2021. AND I'M HAPPY TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS. 4 5 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: DO ANY OF MY COLLEAGUES HAVE ANY 6 7 QUESTIONS? JIM, I SEE YOUR HAND UP. 8 JAMES P. SPERING: DO WE HAVE A POLICY AS TO HOW DUES ARE GOING 9 10 TO BE RAISED, AND SO THAT MEMBERS HAVE ANTICIPATION? DO WE HAVE THAT IN PLACE? 11 12 JESSE ARREGUIN: WE HAVE A FORMULA THAT WE USE BASED ON 13 POPULATION, AND WE MAKE ADJUSTMENTS ACCORDINGLY BUT ONE OF THE 14 THINGS WE TALKED ABOUT IF YOU RECALL LAST FALL WAS LOOKING AT 15 16 ADJUSTING THE DUES STRUCTURE TO MAKE SURE THAT THE DUES BETTER REFLECT THE COST OF ADMINISTRATION. THAT WAS ONE OF THE THINGS 17 MR. MAYHEW PROPOSED FOR THAT PACKAGE OF BUDGET SOLUTIONS TO 18 HELP ADDRESS STRUCTURAL DEFICITS. 19 20 21 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: AND I THINK JIM'S QUESTION WAS AROUND 22 TIMING. I THINK IT'S PART OF THE BUDGET PREPARATION. UNFORTUNATELY, JIM, NO, CITIES AND COUNTIES DON'T KNOW TODAY, 23 BUT THEY KNOW IN, ABOUT, APRIL, I THINK. THERESE, GO AHEAD, 24 25 PLEASE?

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1 THERESE MCMILLAN: I WOULD LIKE TO START WITH COMMITTEE CHAIR 2 3 MITCHOFF TO DISCUSS THE TIMING AND PROPOSALS AND TIMING AND PRIORITY. SO WE INTEND TO REPORT BACK TO THIS FINANCE GROUP 4 5 ONCE I HAVE HAD A CHANCE TO HAVE THAT CONVERSATION WITH THE CHAIRS. 6 7 8 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: JIM DID YOU HAVE A COMMENT ON WHEN THAT 9 SHOULD BE? 10 JAMES P. SPERING: JESSE, THANK YOU FOR YOUR COMMENTS. I JUST 11 REMEMBER LOOKING AT MAYBE A FIVE YEAR SPAN THAT MAYBE EVER 12 APRIL WE'RE GOING TO BE ADJUSTING THE DUES. EVERYONE KNOWS 13 THIS WAS COMING IT'S NOT LIKE WE'RE GOING TO SAY EVERY YEAR, 14 15 WE HAVE A SCHEDULE, AND WE HAVE CONSIDERATIONS AND IT COULD GO 16 UP. I HOPE THAT WE HAVE A PLAN IN PLACE TO LOOK AT THESE DUES. 17 AS YOU ALL KNOW WE HAVE FALLEN SO FAR BEHIND AND IF WE DO IT A LITTLE BIT AT A TIME IT'S A LOT MORE PALATABLE. THAT'S WHY I 18 ASK THAT QUESTION. THANK YOU, KAREN. 19 20 21 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: DAVE HAS BEEN WAVING HIS FINGER. 22 DAVID RABBIT: NOT THIS FINGER. 23 24 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: NO. JUST THE -- THE NICE FINGER. JESSE? 25

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1 DAVID RABBIT: WHAT PERCENTAGE OF REVENUES DO WE ANTICIPATE TO 2 3 GET FROM DUES. WE SHOULD BUILD THAT IN AND REVIEW IT AND SHOULD TAKE THAT OUT WILL WE DO IT THIS YEAR OWE NOT. IT'S 4 5 LIKE THE BRING BRIDGE TOLLS ON THE GOLDEN GATE THE BEST THING THAT HAPPENED WITH THE ELECTRONIC TOLL THAT YOU DON'T HAVE TO 6 WAIT FOR ONE HUGE INCREASE. THEY DO DID INCREMENTALLY WE CAN 7 8 KEEP UP WITH EXPENDITURES AND NOT FALL BEHIND IF WE CAN BUILD THAT INTO A POLICY AND JUST HAVE IT ADOPTED I THINK PEOPLE 9 10 WOULD VOTE FOR THAT AND IT WOULD BE MUCH EASIER. 11 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: BACK TO YOU, JESSE. 12 13 JESSE ARREGUIN: I AGREE. THIS IS GOOD FEEDBACK WE WILL HAVE ON 14 15 THE ADJUSTING THE AMOUNT OF THE DUES STRUCTURE. I WANT TO 16 THANK THE COMMISSIONERS WHO SERVE ON THE ABAG EXECUTIVE BOARD THIS WAS ONE OF THE ACTIONS AND VARIOUS THINGS THAT BRIAN 17 PROPOSED TO ADDRESS THE SURCHARGE IT'S GOING TO HELP US 18 ENORMOUSLY TO HELP US BUILD UP OUR RESERVES AND ADDRESS THE 19 STRUCTURAL DEFICIT FOR US TO BE IN A MUCH STRONGER POSITION. 20 21 THANK YOU, COMMISSIONER SPERING. 22

23 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: IS IT APPROPRIATE FOR THERESE TO SEND
24 OUT A LETTER ON BEHALF OF THE ABAG EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
25 THANKING MTC?

1 JESSE ARREGUIN: THAT WOULD BE GREAT. 2 3 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: THIS IS AS OF OCTOBER 31ST SO IT'S JUST 4 5 THE FIRST OUARTER OF OUR YEAR BUT SINCE WE'RE NOW FINISHED WITH THE SECOND QUARTER DO WE HAVE MANY JURISDICTIONS WHO 6 STILL HAVEN'T PAID THEIR DUES? I KNOW THIS HAS BEEN AN ISSUE 7 8 IN THE PAST, BUT WE'RE IN A LITTLE -- WE, MEANING GOVERNMENT, IN GENERAL, IN A LITTLE BIT BETTER FINANCIAL PICTURE I'M JUST 9 CURIOUS -- HOPEFULLY THIS TIME OF YEAR WE HEAR ONE OR TWO 10 HAVEN'T PAID BUT I'M WONDERING IF --11 12 BRAD PAUL: THE GOOD NEWS IS 98 CITIES HAVE PAID ALL 98 13 COUNTIES HAVE PAID THERE ARE ONLY THREE CITIES LEFT THAT HAVE 14 NOT PAID AND WE'LL BE GETTING IN TOUCH WITH THEM IN THE NEXT 15 16 WEEK OR SO. 17 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: YOU HAVE HEARD FROM THEM THEY'RE HAVING 18 DIFFICULTY? OR THINGS JUST GET PUSHED ASIDE? 19 20 BRAD PAUL: AS YOU MENTIONED TWO OR THREE CITIES JUST DON'T PAY 21 AND USUALLY WHEN YOU REMIND THEM YOU GET THE CHECK IN THE 22 23 MAIL. 24

KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: ANY OTHER QUESTIONS FROM MY COLLEAGUES. 1 2 ALL RIGHT. MR. CASTRO, ANY PUBLIC COMMENT? 3 CLERK, FRED CASTRO: THERE ARE NO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WITH 4 5 THEIR HAND RAISED, AND THERE WAS NO PUBLIC COMMENT SUBMITTED 6 ON THIS ITEM. 7 8 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: ALL RIGHT. IT 22 23 LOOKS PRETTY STRAIGHT FORWARD. THERE WERE NO PURCHASE REQUISITIONS, WE HAVE TWO CONTRACTS, ONE TO PERK DIGITAL IN 24

THE AMOUNT OF 107,001 TO HEALTHY OUTCOMES FOR 10082443 -- 430. 1 2 IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU WISH TO ADD TO THIS? 3 RAYMOND WOO: NO. THAT'S IT YOU GET IT ALL RIGHT. 4 5 KAREN MITCHOFF, CHAIR: WONDERFUL. THEN, I HAVE GOT SO MANY. 6 WE'RE GOING BACK AND FORTH HERE. THIS IS AN ACTION ITEM. THIS 7 8 TIME I THINK MR. SPERING WOULD LIKE TO MOVE AND MR. RABBIT WOULD LIKE TO SECOND? 9 10 JAMES P. SPERING: YES.
