SO, 10 11 THE FIRST THING ON THE CONSENT CALENDAR, IS APPROVAL OF THE ABAG RESOLUTION NUMBER 2211 PROVIDING FOR REMOTE MEETINGS 12 PURSUANT TO A.B. 361. AND WHO WAS THE SECOND? 4 5 ANDRE DUURVOORT: ANDRE DUURVOORT, IS THE SECOND. 6 7 8 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: OKAY. 9 ANDRE DUURVOORT: THANKS ANGELA. 10 11 CLERK, SERENA SEATON: OKAY. 12 13 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: IS THERE ANY DISCUSSION BY THE COMMITTEE 14 ON THIS MOTION? SCHROEDER? 6 7 CHRIS SCHROEDER: YES. 8 9 CLERK, SERENA SEATON: THANK YOU. WALTON? 10 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: YES. 11 12 CLERK, SERENA SEATON: THANK YOU. WILLIAMS? 13 14 15 DOUG WILLIAMS: YES. 16 CLERK, SERENA SEATON: THANK YOU. MOTION PASSES. 17 18 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: THANK YOU. SO MOVING ON TO ITEM FOUR, 19 REQUESTS FOR AUTHORIZE SB 1383 COMPLIANT RENEWABLE NATURAL 20 21 GAS. RYAN JACOBY WILL PROVIDE THE PRESENTATION FOR THIS. 22 23 RYAN JACOBY: SURE. THANKS ANGELA. COULD AV STAFF PULL UP THE PRESENTATION, PLEASE. WE HAVE A BRIEF ONE TODAY. I KNOW THERE 24 25 ARE A COUPLE OF FOLKS WITH CONFLICTS CLOSE TO 11:30. SO,

APOLOGIZE FOR THE SLIGHTLY LONGER THAN USUAL MEETING. NEXT 1 SLIDE PLEASE. AS A VERY BRIEF OVERVIEW OF OUR EXPERIENCE WITH 2 3 SB 1383. IT FIRST SURFACED AS A DISCUSSION TOPIC WHEN MEMBERS CONSISTENTLY EXPRESSED CONCERN WITH COMPLIANCE PATHWAYS AS 4 5 WELL AS THE DESIRE FOR THE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE PROCUREMENT ASSISTANCE. WE CONTINUED TO HEAR THOSE CALLS THROUGHOUT THE 6 STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT PROCESS RESULTING IN THE FORMALIZATION 7 8 OF THIS STRATEGY AND THE STRATEGIC IMPLEMENTATION ROADMAP. AFTER THAT WE ISSUED A SURVEY WITH A COUPLE OF REMINDERS 9 10 EARLIER THIS YEAR, AS WELL AS AN COUPLE OF INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION TO FURTHER IDENTIFY INTEREST AS WELL AS 11 COMMUNICATE POTENTIAL PRICE PREMIUMS. MOST RECENTLY, WE ISSUED 12 A REQUEST FOR OFFERS LAST MONTH THAT PROVIDED US TANGIBLE 13 INFORMATION AND HAS RESULTED IN ONE OR MORE FIRM OFFERS FOR 14 15 COMPLIANT RENEWABLE NATURAL GAS. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. BACK IN 16 JUNE, WE PRESENTED RESPONSES FOR THE FOLLOWING TWO QUESTIONS, JUST AS A REMINDER, AMONGST OTHER STUFF. WE LEARNED FROM THE 17 STAKEHOLDER CONVERSATIONS THAT COMPLIANCE SUPPLY WAS LIKELY TO 18 BE EXTREMELY LIMITED AND PROBABLY WITHIN A BROAD RANGE OF 2 TO 19 7 TIMES AS EXPENSIVE AS FOSSIL BASED GAS. RESPONSES TO 20 21 QUESTION FOUR INDICATED THAT AT EACH PRICE BRACKET THERE WAS SOME INTEREST OR CONSIDERATION IN REPLACING FOSSIL GAS EVEN 22 WITH THOSE PREMIUMS. WE DID END THE SURVEY WITH A RELATIVELY 23 LOW RESPONSE RATE FOR THIS PARTICULAR QUESTION. YOU CAN SEE 24 THAT IDENTIFIED BY THE NINE RESPONDENTS AND THE 12 PEOPLE THAT 25

SKIPPED THIS OUESTION. IN OUESTION FIVE, WE AFFIRMED 1 CONFIRMATION THAT NEARLY 40% OF OUR MEMBERSHIP WAS LOOKING FOR 2 A SOLUTION IN 2023, OR EVEN EARLIER, IF POSSIBLE. ALL 21 3 RESPONDENTS ANSWERED THAT OUESTION. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. THIS 4 5 TAKES US TO LAST MONTH, WITH THE ISSUANCE OF THE RFO, WHICH WAS DISTRIBUTED TO PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS IN ABOUT 20 EXTERNAL 6 FIRMS INCLUDING ANAEROBIC DIGESTERS, CAL RECYCLE 7 8 [INDISCERNIBLE] WASTE AS WELL AS PARTICIPANTS IN OUR STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT PROCESS LAST YEAR. FORTUNATELY, WE 9 10 RECEIVED ONE OR MORE OFFERS WITH QUANTITIES IN THE RANGE OF 500 TO 1,000 BTU PER DAY WITH A MULTI-YEAR CONTRACT PREFERRED 11 IN PRICE ABOUT FIVE TIMES MORE THAN CURRENT FOSSIL BASED GAS. 12 AS YOU CAN TELL, WE'RE SHROUDED IN DETAILS A BIT HERE BECAUSE 13 ARE ONGOING AND PROCUREMENT IS ONGOING AND NEGOTIATION HAS NOT 14 TAKEN PLACE. NEXT SLIDE PLEASE. OVERALL, THE VOLUMES IN THIS 15 16 RANGE WOULD REPRESENT A SIGNIFICANT TRANSACTIONS FOR THE PROGRAM AT ABOUT \$10 MILLION A YEAR AS WELL AS FINANCIAL 17 INVESTMENT IN A SOLE SOLUTION FOR MEETING A MAJORITY OF THE 18 MEMBERSHIPS COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENT. WE ALSO RECOGNIZE THERE 19 ARE OTHER PATHWAYS TO SATISFY THE COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENT AND 20 NOT ALL MEMBERS, IF ANY, WILL BE INTERESTED IN PURSUING THIS 21 PARTICULAR SOLUTION. FOR THAT REASON, THE STAFF RECOMMENDATION 22 BEFORE YOU TODAY IS TO ISSUE A SURVEY TO MEMBERSHIP TO 23 IDENTIFY WHETHER ANY PARTICIPANT IS WILLING TO ACCEPT THE 24 25 OFFER OR OFFERS BEFORE US. NEXT SLIDE, PLEASE. AS POTENTIAL

NEXT STEPS FOLLOWING THE SURVEY, IF NO MEMBERS ARE INTERESTED 1 2 AT THIS TIME, WE WILL SIMPLY DECLINE THE OFFER/OFFERS AND 3 CONSIDER THE ISSUANCE OF ANOTHER RFO AT SOME POINT IN THE FUTURE. IF THE MEMBERSHIP PROVIDES DIRECTION TO DO SO, WE'LL 4 5 DRAFT AND ISSUE AN RFO AT LEAST SIX MONTHS IN THE FUTURE. ON THE OTHER HAND, IF AT LEAST ONE MEMBER IS INTERESTED IN 6 ACCEPTING THE CURRENT OFFER OR OFFERS, THIS WOULD TRIGGER A 7 8 SERIES OF EVENTS ON THE TOP LINE OF THIS SLIDE, BEGINNING WITH OUR INTENT TO CONFIRM THE SUPPORTING COMPLIANCE MATERIALS WITH 9 CAL RECYCLE. FOLLOWING THAT CONFIRMATION WE WOULD SEEK BOARD 10 APPROVAL TO BEGIN DRAFTING A PROGRAM AGREEMENT FOR ANY 11 PARTICIPANTS AS WELL AS NEGOTIATING AND EXECUTING 12 [INDISCERNIBLE] LASTLY, IF DEMAND AMONGST THE MEMBERSHIP 13 EXCEEDS THE OFFER SUPPLIED A METHODOLOGY WOULD NEED TO BE 14 15 DEVELOPED AND APPROVED IN ORDER TO ALLOCATE AVAILABLE SUPPLY 16 AMONG INTERESTED PARTIES. THAT CONCLUDES MY PRESENTATION. AND I AM HAPPY TO TAKE ANY QUESTIONS. THANK YOU. 17 18 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: IS THERE ANY QUESTIONS BEFORE I MOVE FOR 19 20 A MOTION? 21 22 CHRIS SCHROEDER: YES. I HAVE A HAND RAISED. 23

THERE'S A GROUP OF FIVE OR SIX PEOPLE IN PUBLIC WORKS AND UTILITIES THAT ARE WORKING ON THIS. HOW SOON COULD YOU 4 5 PREPARE SOMETHING FOR ME TO TAKE BACK TO SAY HERE ARE YOUR OPTIONS FOR RENEWABLE NATURAL GAS? 6 7 8 RYAN JACOBY: I AM ANTICIPATING NEXT WEEK. 9 CHRIS SCHROEDER: OKAY. THAT WOULD BE GREAT. THANK YOU. 10 11 ANGELA WALTON, CHAIR: ANDRE? 12 13 ANDRE DUURVOORT: THANKS ANGELA. RYAN I'M CURIOUS, TO CLARIFY 14 15 SOMETHING. SO, YOU MENTIONED IF ONE MEMBER IS INTERESTED, THEN 16 WE WOULD MOVE FORWARD WITH A, SOUNDS LIKE A CONVERSATION WITH 17 CAL RECYCLE. CHRIS? 11 12 CHRIS SCHROEDER: I WANT TO TALK ABOUT FOR A MOMENT ABOUT THE 13 WORK WE DID A COUPLE OF MONTHS BACK REGARDING SUPPORTING 14 15 SOLAR. THERE WAS A VERY NICE LETTER THAT CAME OUT THAT WAS 16 SENT TO THE CPUC AND ANOTHER ONE THAT WAS SENT TO GOVERNOR NEWSOM. COPIES OF THOSE LETTERS WERE ALSO SENT TO THE SOLAR 17 RIGHTS ALLIANCE, YOU WILL PROBABLY REMEMBER DAVE ROSENBERG 18 CAME AND SPOKE TO US. THOSE LETTERS AND ALSO SHARED WITH THE 19 NEWSPAPERS AT SEVERAL OF THEIR FUNCTIONS. I'M TOLD THEY'RE 20 21 PROVING BENEFICIAL. THEY REALLY APPRECIATE THE WORK WE DID AND THEY REALLY THINK IT WILL HELP. NOW HAS THE CPUC GIVEN UP 22 TRYING TO DO DASTARDLY THINGS TO SOLAR? NO. IT HAS NOT. IT HAS 23 CHANGED ITS TACTICS AND SOFTENED THE PROPOSAL SOMEWHAT, BUT 24

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THE FIGHT IS NOT OVER YET.
