AGENDA ITEM FIVE NEXT 6 7 GENERATION CLIPPER SYSTEM INTEGRATOR CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER. 8 JASON WEINSTEIN WILL BE PRESENTING ON THIS ITEM. 9 JASON WEINSTEIN: THANK YOU. GOOD MORNING COMMISSIONERS. JASON 10 WEINSTEIN, CLIPPER STAFF. BEFORE I GET STARTED I WANT TO 11 REMIND EVERYBODY THAT THE NEXT GENERATION CLIPPER CONTRACT WAS 12 AWARDED IN 2018 AND SINCE THEN MTC CLIPPER STAFF TRANSIT 13 AGENCY STAFF AND OUR CONTRACTOR HAVE BEEN MAKING STEADY 14 15 PROGRESS TOWARDS DELIVERING THE NEXT GENERATION CLIPPER SYSTEM 16 WHICH WILL GO LIVE NEXT YEAR. SINCE AUGUST OF LAST YEAR, HOWEVER, CLIPPER STAFF HAVE BEEN REPORTING TO THE CLIPPER 17 EXECUTIVE BOARD ABOUT SCHEDULE DELAYS THAT WE HAVE BEEN 18 EXPERIENCING, CAUSED IN PART BY ENGINEERING RESOURCE SHORTAGES 19 AND DELAYS IN THE DELIVERY OF CHIPS AND PLASTICS WHICH 20 21 CONTRIBUTED TO DELAYS. CAN WE PULL UP THE SLIDE, BROADCASTING 22 TEAM? NEXT SLIDE? THANK YOU. THE PROPOSED CHANGE HERE TODAY ADDRESSES THE CURRENT SCHEDULE DELAYS AND IT DOES A NUMBER OF 23 THINGS. IT TIES A FINANCIAL INCENTIVE TO THE START OF CUSTOMER 24

TRANSITION TO THE NEXT GENERATION CLIPPER SYSTEM AS SOON AS



- 1 PRACTICAL. IT DOESN'T CHANGE THE SYSTEM INTEGRATOR CONTRACT
- 2 VALUE OR LENGTH OF OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE PERIOD, AND IT
- 3 ALLOWS THE PROGRAM TO PROCEED WITH AN AGREED UPON SCHEDULE AND
- 4 GREATER CERTAINTY THAN WE HAVE TODAY. I'LL LET SOME OF THESE
- 5 BENEFITS SINK IN FOR YOU. AND WE'LL MOVE TO THE NEXT SLIDE.
- 6 OKAY. I'M GOING TO TALK A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THIS SLIDE HERE IN
- 7 TERMS OF THE PROPOSED CONTRACT CHANGES. FIRST ONE ON THIS
- 8 SLIDE SHOWS THE CURRENT CONTRACT TERMS AS THEY ARE TODAY. THE
- 9 SECOND ROW SHOWS A PROPOSED CHANGES IN RED TO THE CONTRACT
- 10 TERMS AND INTRODUCES THAT FINANCIAL INCENTIVE TO ACHIEVE THE C
- 11 TWO SYSTEM TRANSITION NOTICE TO PROCEED, WHICH I ALLUDED TO IN
- 12 THE PREVIOUS SLIDE. AND THE THIRD ROW SHOWS THE IMPACT TO THIS
- 13 REDUCTION OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE PAYMENTS WHICH ARE SHARED
- 14 BETWEEN MTC AND THE TRANSIT OPERATORS. SO I'LL JUST TAKE A
- 15 SECOND TO -- IN THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT, WE WERE GOING TO GO,
- 16 WHEN WE GET TO REVENUE READY, WE WERE GOING TO MOVE FROM AN
- 17 O&M AT \$300,000 TO \$1.4 MILLION. THAT'S WHAT IT SHOWS IN THE
- 18 MIDDLE COLUMN IN THAT FIRST ROW. AND YOU CAN SEE, IN TERMS OF
- 19 THE PROPOSED CHANGE, AT REVENUE READY, WE'LL INCREASE FROM
- 20 300,000 TO 900,000, AND ONCE WE GET TO THE PLACE WHERE WE'RE
- 21 READY TO TRANSITION CUSTOMERS, THEN WE'LL MOVE TO THE FULL 1.4
- 22 MILLION FOR O&M. SO THAT GIVES THE CONTRACTOR A FINANCIAL
- 23 INCENTIVE TO GET THERE SOONER. LET'S MOVE TO THE NEXT SLIDE.
- 24 FLUSH FLASHING SO THIS SLIDE, HERE, HAS A LOT OF WORDS AND IT
- 25 SHOWS THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR REVENUE READY,



- 1 CUSTOMER TRANSITION, AND THE REDUCTIONS IN THE OPERATIONS AND
- 2 MAINTENANCE PAYMENTS AMOUNT. IT ALSO MODIFIES SEVERAL
- 3 GUARANTEED COMPLETION DATES AS SHOWN IN THAT BOTTOM BULLET.
- 4 AND I WANT TO MENTION THAT NEXT MONTH WE PLAN TO BRING TO THIS
- 5 COMMITTEE A COMPREHENSIVE UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF THE NEXT
- 6 GENERATION CLIPPER SYSTEM AS WELL AS CLIPPER START AND OTHER
- 7 START PROGRAMS AND OTHER DISCOUNT PROGRAMS FOR TRANSIT SO THAT
- 8 YOU CAN HAVE A LARGER PICTURE OF WHAT WE'RE DOING. AT THIS
- 9 TIME STAFF REQUESTS THAT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE IS
- 10 AUTHORIZED TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT
